

JACKET "GIRL" yarn *AZZURRA*



YARN
Adriafil yarns

MATERIALS REQUIRED

550g *Azzurra* of which: 300g lilac no. 72 (A) and 50g for each of the following colours (for the crocheted squares): fuchsia no. 31 (B), purple no. 30 (C), yellow no. 07 (D), turquoise no. 37 (E), blue no. 76 (F). Needles no. 3. Crochet hook no. 2. Tapestry needle with rounded tip.

SIZE: 38 (40-42-44)

PATTERNS STITCHES

Stock stitch
Chain
Single crochet
Double crochet
Half treble
Treble crochet
Double treble

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm. with needles no. 3 in knit st. = 33 sts. and 50 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS GIACCHINO

Back: With needles no. 3 and colour A, cast on 130 (140-150-160) sts. and work in stock st. When work measures 19 (21-23-25) cms., to shape armholes bind off at the sides, every 2 rows, 6 (7-8-9) sts., 3 (4-5-6) sts., 2 sts., 1 st. twice. When work measures 21 cms. from beg. of armholes, bind off all the rem. sts.
Right front: With needles no. 3 and colour A, cast on 44 (49-54-59) sts. and work in stock st. At the same time, to shape the neckline, dec. on right of work, 1 st. every 6 rows 5 (8-11-14) times, 1 st. every 8 rows 10 times, 1 st. every 10 rows 6 times. When work measures 19 (21-23-25) cms, work in the armhole, on left of work, to match the back. When work measures 40 (42-44-46) cms., bind off the rem. sts. for the shoulder.

Left front: Work to match the right front.

Sleeves: With needles no. 3 and the colour A, cast on 100 (106-112-118) sts. and work in stock st. When work measures 35 (36-37-38) cms., to shape armholes bind off at sides 6 sts. and, after 2 rows, 3 sts.; then dec. 1 st. every 4 rows 7 times, 1 st. every 2 rows 22 (24-26-28) times; bind off 4 sts. every 2 rows twice, then , bind off the rem. sts.

Edges: each buttoning edge of the front consists of 6 squares; each edge of the sleeves consist of 5 squares. For each square, using the crochet hook, cast on a chain of 6 sts., Bind off in a loop with 1 sc. in the 1st ch. and, in the loop obtained, work as follows:

Row 1: * 1 half treble (= replace the 1st half treble of each row with 2 chs.), 2 trs., 1 half treble *, rep. from * to * another 3 times; Bind off this row and all the next rows with 1 sc. in the first st..

Row 2: * 2 double trebles tog. (= replace the 1st double tr. of each row with 4 chs.) fitting the crochet hook in the chain of the starting row between the 2 half trs. of row 1, 7 chs. *, rep. from * to *.

Row 3: * 1 dc. in the loop of the 2 double trebles, 7 dc. in the 7 ch. loop *, rep. from * to *.

Row 4: * 1 dc. in each st. below; in the corner st. work 2 trs., 1 ch. and 2 trs. *, rep. from * to *.

Row 5: * 1 dc. in each st. below; in the corner st. work 2 dcs. *, rep. from * to *.

Row 6: 1 dc. in each st. below
Break off and bind the yarn.

Work the squares alternating the colours to each of the first 4 rows (listed in order, from 1 to 4) as follows, start the work with the same colour used for row 1.; work rows 5 and 6 with colour F.

Right front buttoning edge:

mod. 1: E, B, B, A
mod. 2: B, A, A, C
mod. 3: C, D, D, E
mod. 4: D, E, E, B
mod. 5: E, D, D, A
mod. 6: B, A, A, C

Left front button edge:

mod. 1: E, D, D, A
mod. 2: C, D, D, B
mod. 3: B, A, A, E

mod. 4: B, A, A, C
mod. 5: A, E, E, D
mod. 6: D, E, E, B
Right-hand sleeve edge:
mod. 1: E, D, D, A
mod. 2: B, A, A, C
mod. 3: C, D, D, E
mod. 4: D, E, E, B
mod. 5: A, C, C, D
Left-hand sleeve edge:
mod. 1: C, D, D, E
mod. 2: D, E, E, B
mod. 3: B, A, A, E
mod. 4: D, A, A, C
mod. 5: E, D, D, A

FINISHING

Join the squares together, in a row, in the same order indicated in the pattern: join them together with invisible stitches, or using the crochet hook work in single crochet; join the 6th square of the right-hand edge, then work on the other side (= shoulder) 2 rows in treble (= 15 trs.) of which: the first with colour E and the second with colour B; finish the 3 free sides of these rows in double crochet with colour F. Finish off in the same way the 6th square of the left-hand edge with colours C and D (for size upgrades work 3-4-5 or more rows in treble, so as to even off the length with that of the neckline; alternate the colours as you prefer). Join together the 5 square of each sleeve making a strip and closing it with a loop. Sew the shoulder seams. Finish off the neckline of the back and the neckline of each front with the crochet hook and colour F working in 1 row in double crochet. Sew the Edges along the corresponding sections of the front and fix the edge with the rows in treble at the shoulder. Bind off and sew on the sleeves; fix the corresponding edges, along the cuffs, fitting the bottom edges. Sew the side seams. With the crochet hook and colour F work in 2 - 20 cm chains and fix one between the 3rd and 4th square of each edge of the front. For the trim of the front and back bottom w with the crochet hook and colour C cast on a chain of 66 (72-78-84) cms. and work 2 rows in treble, of which the first with colour C and the second with colour B; work 1 row in double crochet with colour F, then, break off and bind the yarn. Fit the trim along the bottom with invisible stitches keeping the row in double crochet along the edge of the jacket.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE BAG

Work in a single piece and decorate with 2 squares.
With needles no. 3 and colour A, cast on 78 sts. and work in stock st. When work measures 20 cm., to shape the bottom, dec. at sides 1 st. every 2 rows 7 times. When work measures 23 cms., incr. at sides 1 st. every 2 rows 7 times. When work measures 46 cms., bind off all the sts.

For each square, follow the instructions given for the jacket alternating the colours as follows:

mod. 1: C, D, D, E
mod. 2: B, A, A, C

FINISHING

Sew in the side edges; fold back the short edges by 2 cms. For the strap, using needles no. 3 and colour A, cast on 9 sts. and work in stock st. for a length of 90 cms.; bind off the sts. Fix the ends the strap in the bag, on the side seas. Sew on the squares with invisible stitches on one side of the bag, as shown in the picture.
