



**YARN**  
Adriafile yarns

**MATERIALS REQUIRED**

150g **Dolcezza Baby**, yellow no. 63. Cotton embroidery 8 white no. 02 and green no. 73. 70 cms. yellow satin ribbon, height 7 mm. 1 ladybird button. Crochet hook no. 2.50. Tapestry needle with rounded tip.

10 x 10 cm. with crochet hook no. 2.50 in fancy stitch = 14 sts. and 10 rows

**WORKING INSTRUCTIONS**

**Cloak:** Start from the top. Cast on a chain of 76 sts. and, starting from 4th chain on the hook, work in treble for 6 rows; at the same time, to shape the cloak incr. 12 sts. in the first 5 rows and 17 sts. in the last row, spaced evenly. When work measures 8 cms., cont. in fancy stitch (= 16 patterns for each row) increasing the number of petals, as the work proceeds, as follows: work 4 petals for 3 rows, 5 petals for 3 rows, 6 petals for 3 rows, 7 petals for 4 rows.

When work measures 34 cms., Break off and bind the yarn.

**Hood:** Cast on a chain of 19 sts. and, starting from the 4th chain on the hook, work in treble. At sides incr. 1 st. every 2 rows 5 times. When work measures 14 cms., break off and bind the yarn.

Cont. the work around the two side edges and the upper edge; work in fancy stitch working in a total of 29 loops in row 1 working in 5-petal patterns (= 9 patterns each row).

When work measures 15 cm. of work in fancy stitch, Break off and bind the yarn.

**FINISHING**

Embroider 9 flowers on the back of the hood, along the edges, and 15 flowers along the yoke, at the base of the 6th row worked in treble stitch of the cloak: work the middle in puff stitch with the white and the leaves in daisy stitch with the green yarn. Sew in the base and the side seams of the hood to the cloak reducing the width. When work measures 33 cms, braid in the ribbon between the troubles of the 1st row of the cloak. Trim the cloak and the hood as follows:

Row 1: in double crochet.

Row 2: \* 2 dcs., 1 popcorn \*, rep. from \* to \*.

Break off and bind the yarn.

Sew on the button and sew in a buttonhole.

**PATTERNS STITCHES**

Chain

Double crochet

Treble crochet

Fancy stitch: over 9 sts.

Row 1: \* 1 dc., 3 chs., skip 2 sts. \*. Rep. from \* to \*, 1 dc.

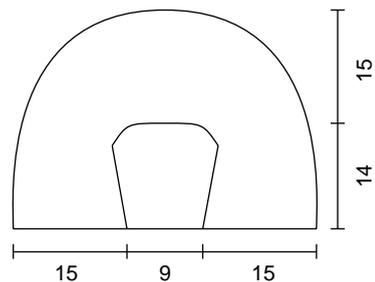
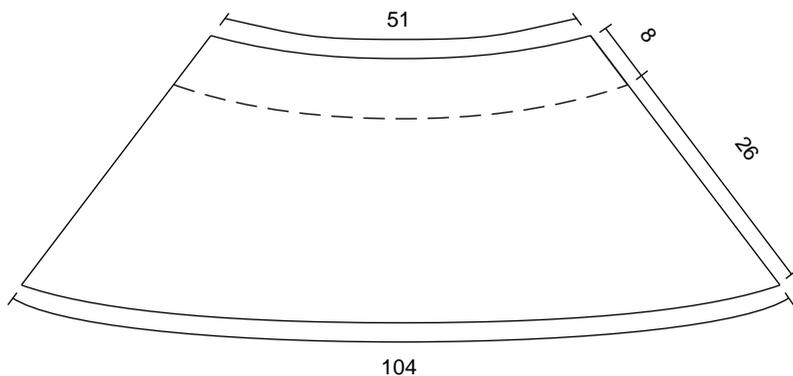
Row 2: 1 dc. (= replace the 1st tr. of every row with 3 chs.), 2 chs., \* 2 trs. closed tog. in the 2 next loop (= work 1 dc. not closed in the 1st loop, 1 dc. not closed in the 2nd loop, wind yarn over the hook and bind off all the sts. ), 2 chs., in the next loop work 4 petals (= for each petal wind over the yarn, fit the hook in the loop, wind over the yarn, pull out a buttonhole and pull yarn gently; wind yarn over again and bind off the sts. on the hook.) separated by 1 ch.; 2 chs. \*. Rep. from \* to \*, 2 trs. closed tog. in the next 2 loops, 2 chs., 1 dc. in the last stitch

Row 3: 1 dc., 3 chs., \* 1 dc. in the loop of the next 2 trs., 3 chs., 1 dc. in the 1st petal, 3 chs., 1 dc. in the 4th petal, 3 chs. \*. Rep. from \* to \*, 1 dc. in the loop of the next 2 trs., 3 chs., 1 dc. in the last stitch

Row 4: repeat from row 2.

**GAUGE**

10 x 10 cm. with crochet hook no. 2.50 in treble = 21 sts. and 7 rows.





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Adriafil yarns

**MATERIALS REQUIRED**

450g **Ninna Ø**, White no. 40. Several grams of Mirage in green no. 80 and yellow no. 05, for the embroidery. Needles no. 41/2. Crochet hook no. 3.50. Tapestry needle with rounded tip.

**DIMENSIONS:** 65x80 cms.

**PATTERNS STITCHES**

- Stock stitch
- Chain
- Single crochet
- Double crochet
- Treble crochet

**GAUGE**

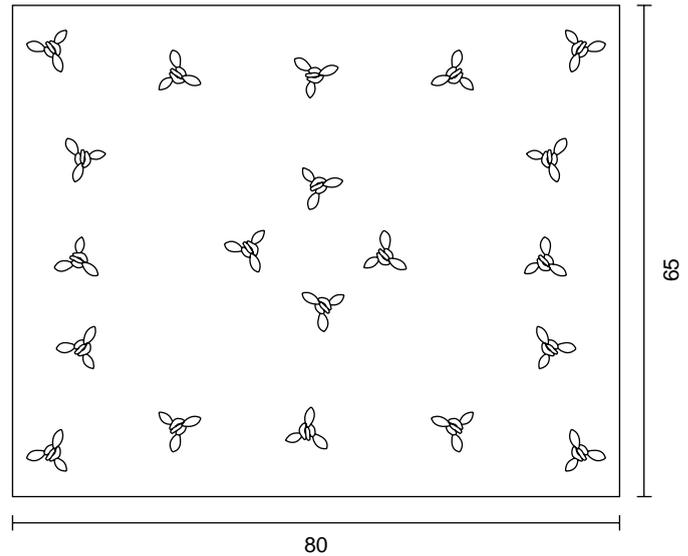
10 x 10 cm. with needles no. 41/2 in knit st. = 14 sts. and 20 rows

**WORKING INSTRUCTIONS**

With needles no. 41/2 Cast on 900 sts. and work in stock st. When work measures 80 cms., bind off all the sts.

**FINISHING**

Finish the edges of the blanket With the crochet hook as follows:  
 Row 1: (start from a corner) in double crochet working in 3 sts. at each corner; bind off this row and all the next rows with 1 sc. in the first st..  
 Row 2: \* in the stitch before the corner, work 1 dc., 3 chs., skip the corner stitch, 1 dc. in the next st.; \*\* (1 ch., skip 1 st., 1 dc. in the next st.) twice, 3 chs., skip 3 sts., 1 dc. in the next st. \*\*, rep. from \*\* to \*\* for the entire side, 1 ch., skip 1 st., 1 dc. in the next st., 1 ch., skip 1 st. \*, rep. from \* to \* for the entire row.  
 Row 3: \* in the corner loop work 7 trs., 1 dc. in the next space, 1 dc. in the next dc., 1 dc. in the next space, \*\* in the next loop work 6 trs., 1 dc. in the next space, 1 dc. in the next dc., 1 dc. in the next space \*\*, rep. from \*\* to \*\* for the entire side \*, rep. from \* to \* for the entire row.  
 Break off and bind the yarn.  
 Embroider the blanket following the pattern of the flower and the model for the layout of the patterns: work the centre in puff stitch with the yellow yarn and the leaves in daisy stitch with the green yarn wound double.
