

SIZE: S (M) L (XL) Garment is shown in S.

GAUGE: ca 13 sts /18 rows = 10 cm

NEEDLES: 6 mm or size to obtain gauge.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

CHEST: 86 (92) 98 (104) cm

LENGTH: 60 (62) 63 (64) cm

YARN: 250 (250) 300 (300)g **Glass** col. 74

BACK

Cast on 54 (60) 66 (72) sts and establish rib stitch on first row (WS) as follows repeating between * * as indicated: S = K4, *p1, k2*, end row with k4. M = K7, *p1, k2*, end row with k7. L = K10, *p1, k2*, end row with k10. XL = K13, *p1, k2*, end row with k13. Next row and all RS rows outside of cabled area: P the purl sts and slip the knit sts from the previous row. Work in rib stitch for 8 (8) 8,5 (9) cm and then begin diagram. At row 20, dec 4 sts as evenly as possible across row. At row 26, inc 4 sts across row as for decs. Continue to work in rib stitch after finishing the diagram.

When piece measures 40 (41) 41 (41) cm, bind off 4,2,1 sts (all sizes) at side for armholes. Continue working in rib stitch until armhole measures 20 (21) 22 (23) cm. Bind off 6 (10) 12 (14) sts at beg of next two rows and continue to work in rib stitch binding off 1 st at each side, 3 times. Bind off remaining sts after 4 cm.

FRONT

Work same as for back.

SLEEVE

Cast on 28 (32) 34 (38) sts and establish rib stitch on first row (WS) as follows: S = K4, *p1, k2* 10 times, end row with k4. M = K6, *p1, k2* 10 times, end row with k6. L = K7, *p1, k2* 10 times, end row with k7. XL = K9, *p1, k2* 10 times, end row with k9. Work for 3 (3,5) 3,5 (4) cm, then begin diagram. At row 20 begin incs as follows: inc 1 st at each side every 4 rows 13 (12) 12 (11) times. Continue to work in rib stitch after finishing the diagram. When the piece measures 51 (52) 52 (53) cm, bind off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows, then 1 st at beg of next 4 rows. Bind off remaining sts.

FINISHING: Join shoulder and neck seams. Set in sleeves. Join side and sleeve seams.

Diagram key: Rows with numbers to the right are right side rows. Rows with numbers to the left are wrong side rows.

(RS) Rightside row symbols: Dot in the square = purl 1; empty square in rib area = slip 1; empty square in cable crossing area = knit 1.

(WS) Wrongside row symbols: Dot in the square = knit 1; empty square = purl 1.

Slanting diagonal lines are stitches to be crossed always towards the upward direction of the slant and using the stitches under the line.

PULL
“DIAMOND”
yarn *GLASS*
