

JACKET “ZEFIRO”

yarn *CHIC*

YARN
 Adriaafil yarns

MATERIAL REQUIRED

400 g. **Chic** cotton, orange no. 65, knitting needles no. 51/2, crochet no. 4.50, tapestry needle with rounded tip.

SIZE 40 (42-44)

PATTERN STITCHES

Knitted stitch
 Chain stitch
 Single crochet
 Treble
 Bobble: 3 chs., 1 single crochet in the 1st chain

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm. with knitting needles no. 51/2 work in knit stitch = 16 stitches and 22 rows

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: With knitting needles no. 51/2 cast on 72 (75-78) sts. and work in knit stitch. When work measures 13 (14-15) cms., to shape the sides dec. at each end work 1 st. every 6 rows twice, work 6 rows, then inc. at each end 1 st. every 4 rows, twice. When work measures 24 (25-26) cms., to shape the sleeve holes bind off at each end 4 sts. and dec. 1 st. after 2 rows. When work measures 17 (18-19) cms. from beg. of sleeve holes, to shape the shoulder slant bind off at each end, every 2 rows, 6 sts. twice, 5 (6-7) sts. Bind off the rem. sts to shape the neckline.

Right front: With knitting needles no. 51/2 cast on 36 (38-40) sts. and work in knit stitch. When work measures 13 (14-15) cms., shape the side on left of work and when work measures 24 (25-26) cms. work the sleeve hole like the back. When work measures 40 (42-44) cms., to shape the neckline bind off on right of work 7 sts. (8-9), then, every 2 rows, 2 sts. 3 times, 1 st. At the

same time, slant the shoulder in the same way as the back.

Left front: work in the same way as the right front.

Sleeves: with knitting needles no. 51/2 cast on 40 (42-44) sts. and work in knit stitch. At each end inc. 1 st. every 10 rows, 5 times. When work measures 30 (32-34) cms., to shape the sleeve holes bind off at each end 5 sts., then, every 2 rows, 3 sts., 2 sts. 3 times, 1 st., 8 times. Bind off the rem. sts.

MAKE UP AND FINISHING

Sew in the shoulders. Close and fit the sleeves. Sew the sides. With the crochet hook finish the back and front neckline, the front buttoning sides and the back and front bottom with 1 row in dc. beginning from a corner of the neckline; after completion, cont. only along the back and front neckline working as follows:

Row 1: * 2 trs. (= replace the 1st tr. of each row with 3 chs.), 2 chs., skip 2 m. *. Rep. from * to *, 2 trs.

Row 2: 4 chs., * 2 trs. in next space, 2 chs., skip the next 2 trs. *. Rep. from * to *, 1 ch., 1 tr. in the last st.

Row 3: 2 trs. in the 1st space, * 2 chs., skip the next 2 trs., 2 trs. in next space *. Rep. from * to *.

Row 4: work in same way as row 2.

5^a r.: work in same way as row 3.

6^a r.: work in same way as row 2.

Without breaking off the yarn, cont. along side of the lace just worked, along the buttoning sides of each front and along the back and front bottom, working in circles as before and alternating the spaces and the groups of 2 trs. After 3 rows, work 1 row as follows: 1 dc. in each space and in each tr. below, working 1 bobble every 4 dcs. Break off and bind the thread.

Finish the bottom of each sleeve repeating rows 1 and 2 of the previous instructions, but working in circles; at the same time, inc. at the seam, 1 st. every row 3 times, in order to make one extra space. When lace measures 9,5 cms., work 1 row of dcs with bobbles as explained for the previous finish. Break off and bind the thread.
