



GILET "BLUE"

yarn TULIP

YARNS
ADRIAFIL YARNS

MATERIALS REQUIRED

650 g Tulip yarn, colour no. 24. Needles no. 8. Crochet hook no. 4.50. Tapestry needle.

SIZE: IT 46 (42-44) - US 12 (10-8) - UKL (M-S)

PATTERN STITCHES

Purled stitch

Mink stitch: work in double crochet working for each st. a long loop; wrap the yarn around a 5 cm ruler or stiff cardboard for each stitch worked.

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm with needles no. 8 in purled stitch = 9 sts. and 11 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: with needles no. 8 cast on 52 (48-50) sts. and work in purled stitch. To shape the sides dec. on each side 1 st. every 10 rows twice. When work measures 46 (44-45) cm., to shape the armholes bind off on each side, every 2 rows, 2 sts. twice, 1 st. When work measures 16 (14-15) cm. from beg. of armholes, for the shoulder slope bind off on each end 7 sts. every 2 rows twice (6 sts. twice - 7 sts., 6 sts.). Bind off the rem. sts. to shape the neckline. **Right front:** with needles no. 8 cast on 26 (24-25) sts. and work in purled stitch. Shape the side, on the left of work, and shape the armhole in same way as back. When work measures 53 (49-51) cm., to shape the neckline bind off, on right of work, every 2 rows, 3 sts., 1 st. twice. When work measures 62 (58-60) cm., shape the shoulder in same way as back. **Left front:** work to match right front.

FINISHING

Sew the shoulders and the sides. With crochet hook no. 4.50 trim all the borders working 1 row in double crochet and 1 row in mink stitch.
