



JACKET "EDNA"

yarn KID MOHAIR

YARNS
ADRIAFIL YARNS

MATERIALS REQUIRED

200 g **Kid Mohair** yarn, cream no. 11 doubled; several grams of the same yarn in the following colours: brown no. 15 and dark green no. 93. Needles no. 41/2. Crochet hook no. 3.50. 250 cm. of 1 cm cream satin ribbon. Embroidery and tapestry needles.

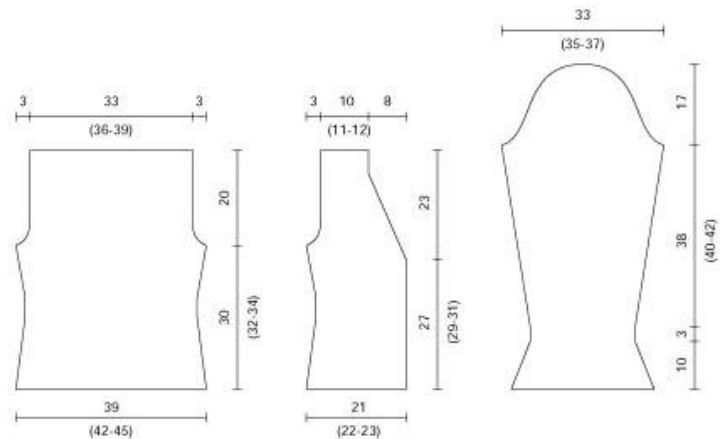
SIZE: IT 40 (42-44) - US 6 (8-10) - UK S (M-L)

PATTERN STITCHES

Knitted stitch
Chain stitch
Single crochet
Double crochet
Embroidery in chain stitch and in daisy stitch

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm with needles no. 41/2 and doubling the yarn work in stockinette stitch = 13 sts. and 23 rows.

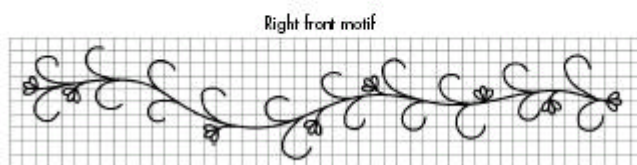
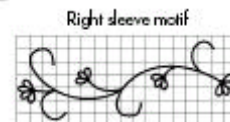
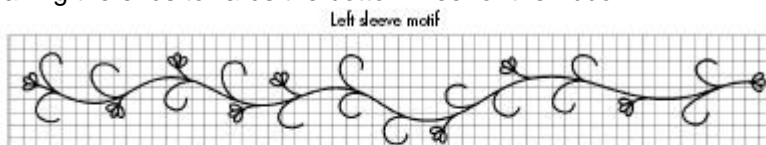


WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: with needles no. 41/2 and doubling the yarn cast on 50 (54-58) sts. and work in knitted stitch To shape the sides, when work measures 12 cm. dec. on each side 1 st. every 6 rows twice; when work measures 23 cm., incr. on each side 1 st. every 6 rows twice. When work measures 30 (32-34) cm., to shape the armholes bind off on each end 2 sts. and dec. 1 st. every 2 rows twice. When work measures 20 cm. from beg. of armholes, bind off the rem. sts. **Right front:** with needles no. 41/2 and doubling the yarn cast on 27 (29-31) sts. and work in knitted stitch On the left of work, shape the side and the armhole in same way as back. At the same time, when work measures 27 (29-31) cm., to shape the neckline dec. rightwise 1 st. every 4 rows 10 times. When work measures 23 cm. from beg. of neckline, bind off the rem. sts. for the shoulder. **Left front:** work to match right front. **Sleeves:** with needles no. 41/2 and doubling the yarn cast on 40 (42-44) sts. and work in knitted stitch On each side dec. 1 st. every 4 rows 4 times. When work measures 13 cm., incr. on each side 1 st. every 10 rows 6 times. When work measures 51 (53-55) cm., to shape the armholes dec. on each side 1 st. every 2 rows 19 times. Bind off the rem. sts.

FINISHING

Embroider the right front and over the sleeves following the corresponding charts: embroider the branches in chain stitch with the brown yarn; with the green yarn work the buds and in daisy stitch and the stems in chain stitch. Sew the shoulders. Join and fit the sleeves. Sew up the sides. With crochet hook no. 3.50 trim all the borders of the front, back and back of the sleeves as follows: **Row 1:** in dc.; end all the rows with 1 sc. in the initial st. **Row 2:** * 1 dc, 4 chs., skip 2 sts. along the horizontal edges, 3 sts. along the vertical edges or 4 sts. along the slanted edges (neckline) *, rep. from * to *. **Row 3:** 6 dc in each loop below Break off and bind the yarn. With the satin ribbon make the front lace: braid the ribbon into the loops along the buttoning edge leaving the ends towards the bottom free for the ribbon.



Enlarge the motifs until each square of the chart becomes cm. 1
