yarns *COLOR* and *RAFIA*

YARNS ADRIAFIL YARNS

TOP

MATERIAL REQUIRED

250 g **Color** no. 83. Knitting needles no. 6. 2 buttons. Tapestry needle.

SIZE: IT 42 (44-46) - US 8 (10-12) - UK M (L-XL)

PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib (beginning and end)
K1/p1 rib stitch
Purled stitch
Knitted stitch
Shell stitch to end the Elastic rib

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 with knitting needles no. 6 in purled stitch = 15 sts. and 21 rows.

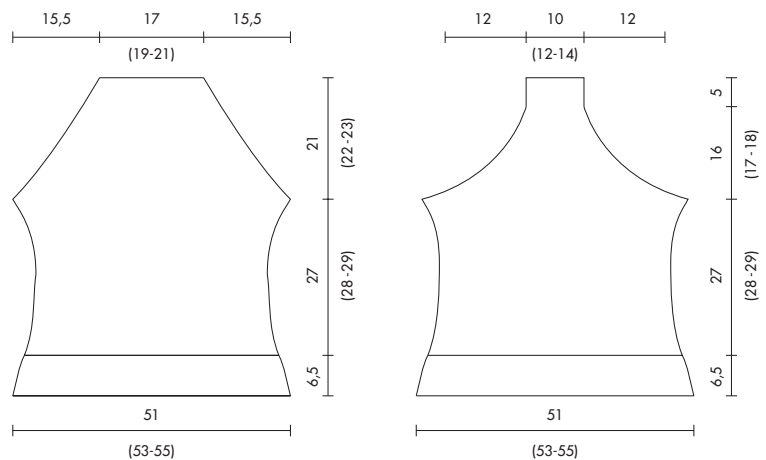
WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: with knitting needles no. 6 cast on 81 (84-87) sts. and work 4 rows. in elastic rib, then in k1/p1 rib st. for a total of 6,5 cm. Cont. in purled stitch decr. 4 sts. evenly over the first row. On each side, decr. 1 st. every 6 rows 5 times. When work measures 18 cm (18-19) from the edge, incr. at each end 1 st. every 6 rows 3 times. When work measures 27 cm (28-29) from the edge, to shape the armholes bind off on each side, 2 sts. and decr., inside the first and the last 4 sts. (which must be worked in knitted st.), 1 st. every 2 rows. 23 times. When work measures 21 cm. (22-23) cm from the beg. of the armholes, stand off all the rem. stitches.

Front: work to match the front until work measures 27 cm. (28-29) from the edge. To shape the armholes bind off on each side, 2 sts. and decr., inside the first and the last 4 sts. (which must be worked in knitted st.), 1 st. every 2 rows. 16 times. Cont. over the rem. sts. at the pick up point for another 5 cm, then stand off the stitches.

FINISHING

For the neck, pick up the standing sts. of the front, then cast on another 22 (23-24) sts, pick up the standing sts. of the back, then cast on another 22 (23-24) sts.; work in k1/p1 rib st. for 6 cm., then in elastic rib for 6



YARN ADRIAFIL YARNS

HAT

MATERIAL REQUIRED

100 g Rafia, **Red** no. 71. Crochet hook no. 5.00. 90 cm red satin ribbon H 1.5 cm.

DIMENSIONS: the hat has an inner diameter of 20 cm and an outer diameter of 37 cm, including the brim.

PATTERN STITCHES

Chain stitch
Single crochet
Double crochet
Half treble crochet
Treble crochet
Bobble: 3 chs, 1 sc. in the first chain

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on a chain of 7 sts., ending with a 1 sc. loop in the first chain and, in the loop obtained, work:

Row 1: 18 trs. (= replace the first tr. of each row with 3 chs); end this row and all succ. rows with 1 sc. in the initial st.

Row 2: 1 tr., * 2 trs. in the next st., 2 trs. *, rep. from * to * another 7 times (= 26 sts.), 1 tr.

Row 3: 2 trs. in each st. below (= 52 sts.).

Row 4: * 1 tr. in each of the next 3 sts., 1 tr. pushing the crochet hook into the same base as the first of the 3 trs. *, rep. from * to * working in 14 incrs. in the row (= 22 groups).

Row 5: 1 half. tr. in each st. below

Row 6: * 1 tr. in each of the next 3 sts., 1 tr. pushing the crochet hook into the same base as the first of the 3 trs. *, rep. from * to * (= 28 groups).

Row 7: * 2 trs., 1 ch., skip 2 trs. *, rep. from * to *.

Row 8: * 1 tr. in each of the next 2 sts., 1 tr. in the space of 1 ch., 1 tr. pushing the crochet hook into the same base as the first of the 3 trs. *, rep. from * to *.

Row 9: * skip the first st. of the group, 1 tr. in each of the next 3 sts., 1 tr. in the st. skipped *, rep. from * to *.

Row 10: * 1 tr. in each of the next 3 sts., 1 ch., skip the next st. *, rep. from * to *.

Row 11: 1 tr. in each of the trs. below, 2 trs. in the space of 1 ch. *, rep. from * to *.

Row 12: * skip the first st. of the group, 1 tr. in each of the next 3 sts., 1 tr. in the st. skipped, 1 ch. *, rep. from * to *.

Row 13: * skip the first st. of the group, 1 tr. in each of the next 3 sts., 1 tr. in the st. skipped, 2 chs. *, rep. from * to *.

Row 14: * skip the first st. of the group, 1 tr. in each of the next 3 sts., 1 tr. in the st. skipped, 3 chs. *, rep. from * to *.

Row 15: 1 sc. on the first 2 trs., in the next st. work 2 trs., 1 bobble and 2 trs.; * 1 dc. in the 3 ch. loop, skip the first 2 sts. of the next group, in the next st. work 2 trs., 1 bobble and 2 trs. *, rep. from * to *.

Break off and bind the yarn.

FINISHING

Fit the satin ribbon between the stitches of row 11, tying the ends into a bow.
