

PULL "LEMON"

yarn *SPICE*



YARNS ADRIAFIL YARNS

MATERIAL REQUIRED

500 g. **Spice**, Pale yellow no. 25. Knitting needles no. 4. Tapestry needle.

SIZE: IT 44 (42-46) - US 10 (8-12) - UK L (M-XL)

PATTERN STITCHES

Garner stitch

Purled stitch

Centre motif (work over 19 sts.): follow the diagram.

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 using knitting needles no. 4 in purled stitch = 21 sts and 28 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: using knitting needles no. 4 cast on 101 (97-105) sts. and work in garner st.. When work measures 2 cm., to shape the edge of the splits, work 4 sts. in garner st., 93 (89-97) sts. in purled stitch, 4 sts. in garner st.. When work measures 4 cm., cont. working over all the stitches. in purled stitch When work measures 36 (34-38) cm., to shape the armholes decr. on each side, 1 st. every 2 rows. 28 times as follows: on the first 6 sts. (right side of work) 2 sts. in knitted st., p2 tog. (later, work the st. worked in purled stitch), 1 yo., p2 tog.; over the last 6 sts. (wrong side of work) p2 tog., 1 yo., p2 tog., 2 sts. in knitted st. (purl over the centre sts. and on the return row work the sts. as they stand; on next row (right side of work) work 2 sts. in knitted st., 2 sts. in purled stitch, p2 tog.; work the succ. sts. in purled stitch and, over the last 6 sts., p2 tog., 2 sts. in purled stitch, 2 sts. in knitted st. At the end of the 27th decr. work 1 row as follows: 2 sts in knitted st., 1 st. in purled stitch, drop the next st. letting it ladder to the beg. of armhole, 1 yo., p2 tog.; work the succ. sts. in purled stitch and, over the last 6 sts. work as follows: p2 tog., drop the next st. letting it ladder to the beg. of armhole, 1 st. in purled stitch, 2 sts. in knitted st.; on next return row k1 in the yo. below; work 2 rows in the same way, then bind off the stitches. (20 cm from the beg. of the armholes).

Front: using knitting needles no. 4 cast on 100 (96-104) sts. and work in garner st.. When work measures 2 cm., to shape the edge of the splits and the centre motif, establish the sts. as follows: 4 sts. in garner st., 37 (35-39) sts. in purled stitch, 18 sts. for the centre motif, 37 (35-39) sts. in purled stitch, 4 sts. in garner st. When work measures 4 cm., work in purled stitch even over the sts. of the edge of the splits. When work measures 36 (34-38) cm., shape the armholes like the back. When work measures 54 (52-56) cm., to shape the neckline bind off the 15 (13-17) centre sts. and complete the two sections separately; bind off centrewise, every 2 rows, 6 sts. twice, 3 (2-4) sts.

Sleeves: using knitting needles no. 4 cast on 60 st. and work in garner st.. When work measures 2 cm., work 21 sts. in purled stitch, 18 sts. for the centre motif, 21 sts. in purled stitch When work measures 16 (15-17) cm. from the edge, incr. at each end 1 st. every 8 rows 6 times. When work measures 34 (32-36) cm. from the edge, to shape the armholes decr. on each side, inside 2 sts. (which must be worked in knitted st.), 1 st. every 2 rows. 28 times. When work measures 20 cm from the beg. of the armholes, bind off the rem. stitches.

FINISHING

Sew up the raglans on three sides. Pick up 122 (118-126) sts. around the neckline and work in knitted st. for 3 cm.; bind off the stitches. Sew up the last raglan and the sides of the collar. Sew up the section from cuff to side.
