

DRESS "MARA"



JAZZ Yarn

BAG

MATERIALS REQUIRED

200 g Jazz yarn in colour no. 45. Knitting needles no. 4.

DIMENSIONS: the bag measures 24.5x22 cm. (closed), including fringe

N.B. To obtain the compact effect of fabric, the yarn is worked with smaller knitting needles than those normally required.

PATTERN STITCHES

Checker stitch (total number of stitches must be a multiple of 6 + 3): work 3 sts. in knitted st. , * 3 sts. in purled st. , 3 sts. in knitted st. * , rep. from * to * ; alternating work every 3 rows working in knitted st. above the purled st. and vice versa.

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm. with knitting needles no. 4 in checker st. = 16 sts. and 25 rows

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

With knitting needles no. 4 cast on 39 sts. and work in checker st. . When work measures 59 cm. from beg., bind off the stitches

MAKE UP AND FINISH

Fold over the band obtained (see pattern) by 21 cm and sew up the side edges.

Trim the short edge of the flap with the fringe as follows: cut 15 cm. lengths of yarn joining them in twos, fold in half and work into the edge st. with the crochet hook then knot. Fasten a fringe into each motif of the checker stitch. Even off the fringe if necessary with a pair of scissors. With the remaining yarn make a 100 cm. plait and fasten to the side of the opening to make the shoulder sbetweenp.

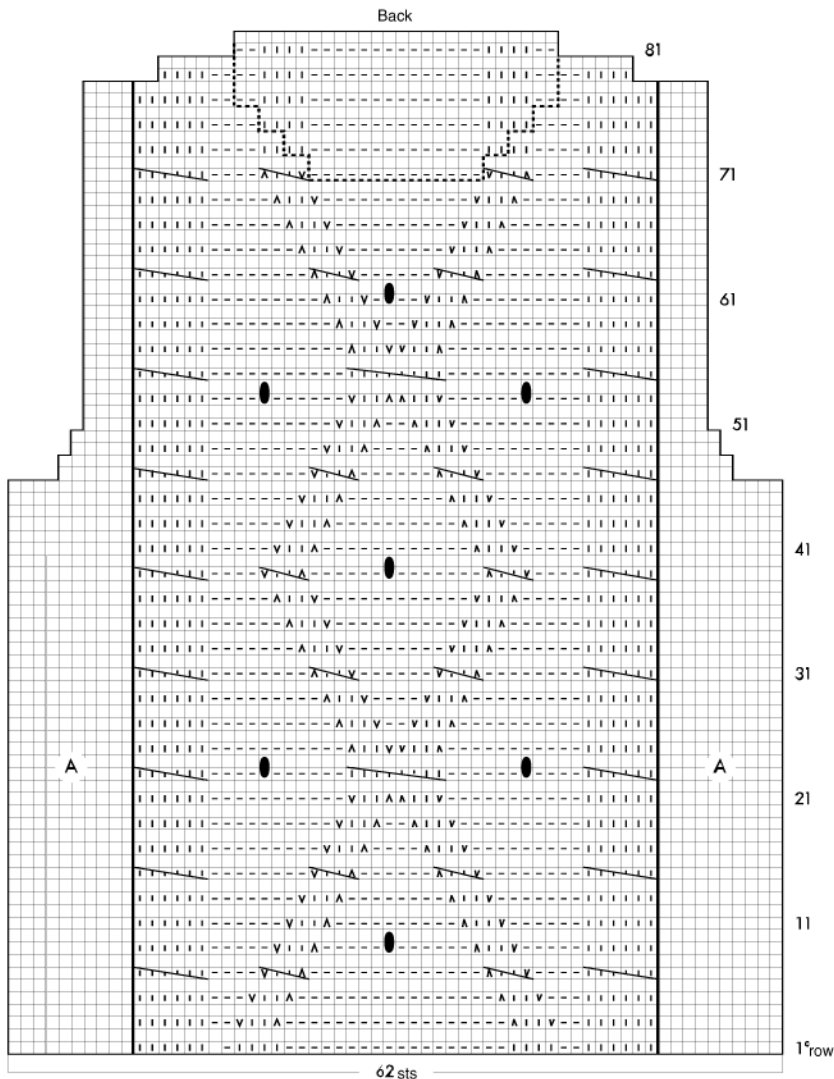


Chart for pullover

- A = purlled stitch
 - = k1
 - = p1
 - = 6 sts. bound off leftwise (stand off 3 sts. on cable holder in front of work, k3, knit standing stitches)
 - = bind off 4 sts. leftwise "A" (stand off 2 sts. on the cable holder in front of work; in the yarn stretched between the last stitch of the right-hand needle and the 1st stitch of the left needle, work p1; k2; pick up the standing stitches and then k1; slip next st. holding yarn at back of work; purl next stitch then pass the slipped st. on purlled st.)
 - = bind off 4 sts. leftwise "B" (stand off 2 sts. on cable holder in front of work; place last purlled st. on left-hand needle and then knit tog. with the next 1st stitch; k1; knit up the standing stitches, then in the yarn stretched between the last stitch and the 1st stitch on the left-hand needle, p1 in back loop)
 - = bind off 8 sts leftwise (stand off 4 stitches on the cable holder in front of work, k4, knit up the standing stitches)
 - = 1 bobble
 - = 1 stitch as it presents itself
 - = front neckline
- Each square corresponds to 1 st. and 1 row
