

# DRESS "MARA"



## JAZZ Yarn

**MATERIAL**  
ADRIAFIL YARNS

### PULL

#### MATERIALS REQUIRED

600 g Jazz yarn in colour no. 45. Knitting needles no. 7 and no. 8. Cable needle no. 8. Crochet hook no. 6.00. Tapestry needle with rounded tip.

**SIZE:** 42 (44-46) - US 8 (10-12) - UK M (L-XL)

#### PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib (start)

Rib stitch 2/2

Purled stitch

Plait stitch (work over 6 sts.):

**Row 1, 3 and 5:** knitted stich.

**Row 2 and next even rows:** in purled stitch.

**Row 7:** 6 sts. crossed leftwise (= stand off 6 sts. on cable needle in front of work, k3, knit standing stitches).

**Row 9:** rep. from row 1.

Centbetweenl motif (work over 30 sts.): follow the chart.

Nut: work in at end of work. Fit crochet hook into the base stitch and fasten the yarn, 3 ch., in the same base stitch work 5 trs. tog. picking up with the crochet hook 2 rows of the basic work; break off and bind the yarn at the back of work.

#### GAUGE

10 x 10 cm. with knitting needles no. 8 and the different stitches = 13 sts. and 15 rows.

#### WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

**Back:** with knitting needles no. 7 cast on 62 (66-70) sts. and work 2 rows in elastic rib, then in rib st. 2/2. When work measures 9 cm. from beg., cont. with knitting needles no. 8 and establish the sts. as follows: 10 (12-14) sts. in purled st., 6 sts. for the plait, 30 sts. for the centbetweenl motif, 6 sts. for the plait, 10 (12-14) sts. in purled st. (follow the chart). When work measures 31 (32-33) cm. from the edge, to shape the armholes bind off at ends 4 sts. and dec. 1 st. every 2 rows twice. When work measures 20 (21-22) cm. from beg. of armholes, to shape the shoulder slant bind off at ends, every 2 rows, 6 sts. twice (7 sts., 6 sts. - 7 sts. twice), then bind off the rem. stitches.

**Front:** work to match back. When work measures 47 (49-51) cm. from the edge, to shape the neckline, bind off the 14 (16-18) centre sts. and finish the two parts separately binding off again centrewise, 2 sts. every 2 rows 3 times. When work measures 6.5 cm. from beg. of neckline, bind off the rem. stitches for each shoulder.

**Sleeves** with knitting needles no. 7 cast on 28 (30-32) sts. and work a border in same way as back. Cont. with knitting needles no. 8 and establish the sts. as follows increasing 2 sts. in the 1st row.: 12 (13-14) st. in purled st., 6 sts. for the plait, 12 (13-14) sts. in purled st. At the sides, inc. 1 st. every 8 rows 5 times and work the new stitches in purled st.; at the same time, inc. at the sides, of the plait 1 st. every 8 rows 5 times. When work measures 32 (33-34) cm. from the edge, to shape the armholes bind off at ends, every 2 rows, 4 sts., 3 sts., 2 sts., 1 st. 9 (10-11) times. When work measures 15 (16-17) cm. from beg. of armholes, bind off the rem. stitches.

#### MAKE UP AND FINISH

Finish the fronts working in the nuts with the crochet hook as shown by the chart. Sew up the shoulder. With knitting needles no. 7 pick up 58 (62-66) sts. around the neckline and work in rib st. 2/2; when work measures 18 cm. from beg., bind off all the stitches. Sew up the other shoulder and the sides of the collar allowing for the cuff. Join and sew on the sleeves. Sew up the sides.
