

TWIN SET "GRETA"



CHARME Yarn

MATERIALS
ADRIAFIL YARNS ADRIAFIL

JACKET

MATERIALS REQUIRED

700 g, **Charme** Yarn, cream no.79, Knitting Needles no. 8. A pair of 22 cm leather belts with buckle. Tapestry needle with rounded tip

SIZE: 42 (44-46) - US 8 (10-12) - UK M (L-XL)

PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib (start up)
Knitted stitch
Rib stitch 1/1
Shell stitch to join the stitches

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm with knitting needles no. 8 work in knit stitch = 9.5 sts and 13.5 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: with knitting needles no. 8 cast on 43 (46-49) sts. and, to work the edge work in elastic rib for 4 rows then in rib st. 1/1. When work measures 13 cm. from beg., cont. working in knit stitch. When work

measures 22 (24-26) cm. from edge, to shape the armholes decr. at sides, inside 1 edge st., 2 sts. every 4 rows 3 times. When work measures 22 (23-24) cm. from beg. of armholes, bind off rem. stitches.

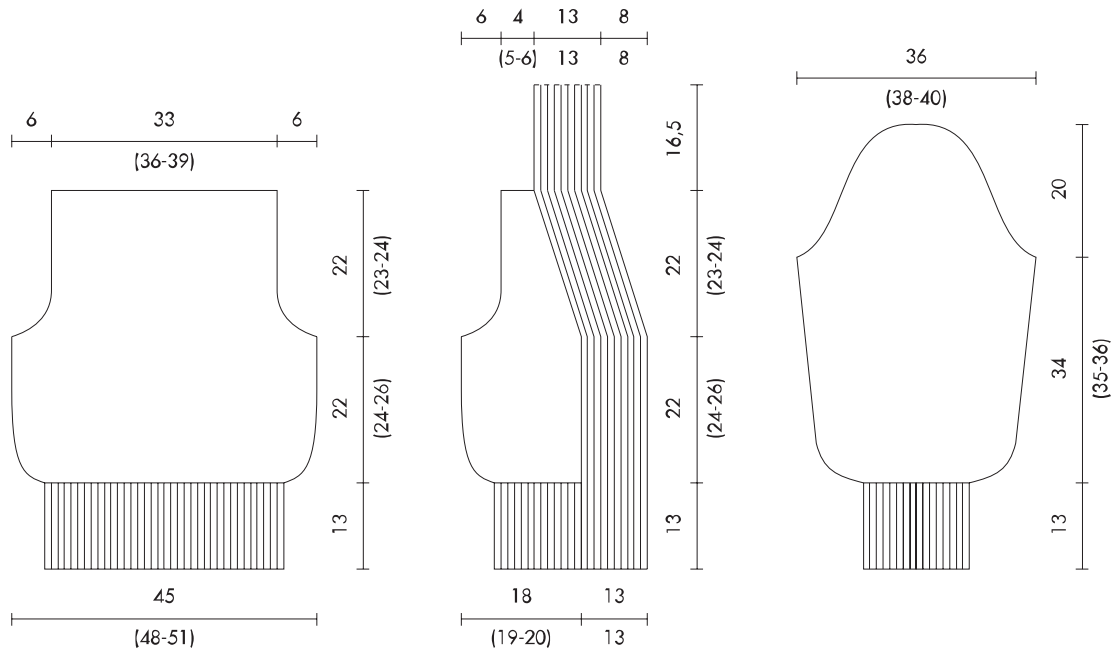
Right front: with knitting needles no. 8 cast on 38 (39-40) sts. and work the edge in same way as back. cont. establishing stitches as follows: 20 sts. in rib st. 1/1 (buttoning edge), 18 (19-20) sts. in knit stitch, when work measures 22 (24-26) cm. from edge, shape the armhole, on left of work, in same way as back, and at the same time, to shape the neckline, decr. on right of work, in the first 20 sts. of edge, 1 st. every 4 rows. 8 times. When work measures 22 (23-24) cm. from beg. of neckline, bind off on left of work 4 (5-6) sts. to shape shoulder and cont. over the rem. 20 sts. of the edge for 16,5 (17-17,5) cm; stand off stitches

Left front: work to match Right Front.

Sleeves: with knitting needles no. 8 cast on 24 (26-28) sts. and work the edge in same way as back. cont. to work in knit stitch increasing at sides 1 st. every 8 rows 5 times. When work measures 34 (35-36) cm. from edge, to shape the armholes decr. at sides, inside 1 edge st., 2 sts. every 4 rows 7 times. When work measures 20 cm. from beg. of armholes. Bind off rem. stitches.

MAKE UP AND FINISH

Join standing stitches on neck in shell st. Sew up shoulders and the edge of the back neckline border. Join and sew on the sleeves. Sew up the sides. Establish the position of the belts on each front (on our model these are sewn at 10 cm. from the respective sides); join the first belt immediately after the waistband, and the sew with d 6 cm above the first.



HAT

MATERIALS REQUIRED

100 g. **Charme** yarn in cream no. 79 worked doubled. Knitting needles no. 12. Crochet hook no. 8. Tapestry needle with rounded tip.

DIMENSIONS: circumference 56 cm.

PATTERN STITCHES

Rib stitch 1/2 (k1, p2, in columns)
Chain
Single crochet
Double crochet

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm. with knitting needles no. 12 and the yarn worked doubled in rib st. 1/2 = 7,5 sts. and 8,5 f.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

with knitting needles no. 12 and the yarn worked doubled cast on 42 sts. and work in rib st. 1/2 starting with p1, * k1, p2 *, rep. from * to * e term. con k1, p1. When work measures 15 cm.

from beg., purl the purled stitches in twos; on the return row work stitches knitted tog. in twos, then break off the yarn leaving a long length of yarn. Pass the yarn through the rem. stitches, pulling it to tighten all the stitches firmly and fastening it on the back.

MAKE UP AND FINISH

Sew the vertical edges of the hat. With the crochet hook trim the bottom edge in dc. and, without breaking off the yarn, to shape the peak work the next 21 sts. in dc., then turn work over, 1 ch., skip 1 st., 19 sc., 1 ch., 1 sc. in the 1st st. of the 1st row. Break off and bind the yarn.
