

“TERESA” VEST



yarn *MEMPHIS*

MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

MATERIALS REQUIRED

A total of 300 g yarn **Memphis** consisting of 100 g rust brown no. 44, 100 g orange no. 98, 50 g. dark pink no. 31 and 50 g. écru no. 12. Knitting needles no. 4. Crochet hook no. 3.50. Tapestry needle with rounded tip.

ONE SIZE

PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib (start)

Zig-zag stitch (work over a number of stitches which are a multiple of 13+2):

Rows 1 and 3: k1, * 2 sts. in 1 tr. (= in the same base st. work k1 and k1 in back loop), k4, slip1, knit 2 tog. pass slipped st. over k4, 2 sts. in 1 dc (= in the same base st. work knit 1 in back loop and k1) *, rep. from * to *, k1

Row 2: purled stitch

Row 4: knitted stitch.

Row 5: rep. from row 1

Double crochet

Crab stitch: work like a double crochet from left to right.

GAUGE

10x10 cm. with knitting needles no. 4 in zig-zag st. = 16 sts. and 24 rows

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: using knitting needles no. 4 and the rust brown yarn, cast on 119 sts. and work 6 rows in elastic rib. cont. in zig-zag stitch alternating the colours every 16 rows as follows: rust brown, orange, dark pink, écru, rust brown, orange, then end with the dark pink. At the same time, to shape the sides decr. at ends 1 st. every 6 rows 6 times, 1 st. every 4 rows 10 times. When work measures 34 cm. from beg. to shape the armholes bind off at ends 4 sts., then decr. 1 st. every 2 rows 3 times; at the same time, space 9 decreases between the sts. and cont. in knitted st. every 4 rows twice (= in the sections where you have worked the decreases, work in zig-zag st. with k3 instead of k4.). When work measures 47 cm. from beg. to shape the neckline bind off the 31 centre sts. and end the two sections separately. When work measures 17 cm. from beg. of sleeve holes, to slant the shoulders bind off at ends 6 sts. every 2 rows twice.

Front: work in the same way as back, but working the neckline at 43 cm. from beg.

MAKE UP AND FINISH

Sew up the shoulders and the sides. With the crochet hook and rust brown yarn trim the neckline and the sleeve holes working a row in double crochet and a row in crab stitch.
