

“DALLAS” SHORT JACKET



GENZIANA and ODEON LAMÉ yarns

MATERIALS ADRIAFIL YARNS

MATERIALS REQUIRED

A total of 360 g. yarns subdivided in 300 g **Genziana** yarn, of which 250 g. orange no. 37, 20 g. for each of the blue colours no. 22, sky blue no. 33, white no. 02 and yellow no. 34, 10 g. for each of the green no. 32 and fuchsia no. 35; 10 g. Odeon silver lame no. 40. Knitting needles no. 31/2, no. 41/2 and no. 5. Orange 40 cm. zipper. Tapestry needle.
N.B. Yarn is worked doubled or single as per patterna and make up.

AGE: 8 years

PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib (start and end)
Rib stitch 1/1
Rib stitch 2/2
Knit stitch
Garer stitch
Knit stitch to work over elastic rib

GAUGE

10x10 cm. with knitting needles no. 5 and yarn worked doubled in knit st. = 19 sts. and 27 rows.
10x10 cm with knitting needles no. 31/2 and with yarn worked single in rib st. 2/2 = 31 st. and 38 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: with knitting needles no. 41/2 and the orange yarn worked double cast on 72 sts. and, to shape the edge, work 4 rows in elastic rib and 2 rows in rib st. 1/1, corresponding to a total of 1.5 cm. Cont. with knitting needles no. 5 in knit st. At sides incr. 1 st. every 12 rows 3 times. When work measures 22 cm. from edge, to shape the armholes bind off at sides, every 2 rows, 4 sts., 2 sts. 2 times. When work measures 7 cm. from beg. of armholes bind off all rem. stitches.

Right front: with knitting needles no. 41/2 and the orange yarn worked double cast on 38 sts. and work the edge in same way as back. Cont. with knitting needles no. 5 and work: 2 garter sts., k36, increasing, on left of work, 1 st. every 12 rows, 3 times. When work measures 22 cm. from edge, shape the armhole in same way as back. When work measures 34 cm. from edge, to shape the neckline bind off on right of work, every 2 rows, 7 sts., 3 sts., 2 sts., 1 st. 3 times. When work measures 5 cm. from beg. of neckline, bind off the rem. 18 sts for the shoulder.

Left front: work to match right front.

Sleeves: with knitting needles no. 31/2 and the blue yarn worked single cast on 54 sts; work 4 rows in elastic rib, then cont. in rib st. 2/2 alternating the colours as follows (always work with single yarn): 12 rows in blue, 12 rows in orange, 10 rows in sky blue, 2 rows in blue, 4 rows in sky blue, 12 rows in orange, 2 rows in blue, 12 rows in white, 2 rows in silver, 8 rows in green, 6 rows in yellow, 12 rows in orange, 4 rows in blue, 8 rows in sky blue, 12 rows in yellow, 2 rows in silver, 8 rows in fuchsia, 4 rows in blue, then end work with the orange yarn. At the same time incr. at sides 1 st. every 6 rows 18 times. When work measures 34 cm. to shape the armholes bind off at sides 2 sts. every 2 rows 6 times. When work measures 3 cm. from beg. of armholes bind off the rem. stitches.

MAKE UP AND FINISH

Sew up the shoulders. With knitting needles no. 41/2 and the orange yarn worked double pick up 72 sts. around the neckline and, for the collar work in rib st. 1/1 for 6 rows, corresponding to 2.5 cm.; cont. in elastic rib for 4 rows, then pass over with tapestry needle. Join and sew on the sleeves. Sew up the sides. Sew on the zipper.
