

# TWIN SET "ORCHIDEA"



## yarn *MEMPHIS*

### MATERIAL ADRIAFIL YARNS

### MATERIALS REQUIRED

450 g. **Memphis** yarn in black no. 01. Knitting needles no. 3 and no. 4. Tapestry needle.

**Size:** 40 (42-44)

### PATTERN STITCHES

Rib stitch (beg. and finish)  
Knitted stitch  
K2/p2 rib

### GAUGE

10x10 cm. work with knitting needles no. 4 in stock stitch = 22 sts. and 28 rows

### WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

**Back:** with the knitting needles no. 3 cast on 138 (143-148) sts. and work 2 rows in rib st. and 8 rows in k2/p2 rib, for a total of 2 cm. Cont. with knitting needles no. 4 in stock stitch decreasing 31 sts. over first row. When work measures 18 (20-22) cm. from border decr. at ends, inside 2 sts., 2 sts. and rep. these decrs. after another 18 (20-22) cm.; then decr. 2 sts. every 10 rows 3 times. When work measures 73 (76-80) cm. from border cont. with knitting needles no. 3 in k2/p2 rib for 8 rows, increasing 7 (9-11) sts. over first row., then work in rib st. for 2 rows, corresponding to a height of 2 cm. of the border; graft stitches with tapestry needle.

**Front:** work like the back until work measures 73 (76-80) cm. from starting border. To shape the armholes bind off at ends 8 (9-10) sts. then decr. inside 2 sts., 2 sts. every 4 rows 4 times. When work measures 6 cm. from beg. of armholes cont. with knitting needles no. 3 in k2/p2 rib for 8 rows, increasing 17 (19-23) sts. over first row., then work in rib st. for 2 rows, corresponding to a height of 2 cm. of the border; graft stitches with tapestry needle.

**Borders of the armholes and shoulder straps:** with knitting needles no. 3 cast on 116 (120-124) sts. and work 2 rows in rib st., 6 rows in k2/p2 rib and 2 rows in rib st., for a total of 2 cm. Graft stitches with tapestry needle. Work 2 identical borders.

### MAKE UP AND FINISH

Sew up borders starting from the armholes leaving the extra part free (shoulder straps); join the free end to the upper border of the back, at 8 cm. from the corresponding side. Join the side seams of the borders of the armholes at the ends of the top border of the back. Sew up the sides.
