



OUTFIT "ONTARIO"

Yarn MERINO

SCARF

YARN

Adriafil Yarns

MATERIALS

150 g. orange no. 50 **Merino** yarn; several grams of the same yarn in white no. 02 and black no. 01

Knitting needles no. 5

Crochet hook no. 4.50

Tapestry needle

DIMENSIONS: 16x102 cm.

PATTERN STITCHES

K1/p1 rib, Chain stitch, Double crochet, Long stitch

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm. work with knitting needles no. 5 in k1/p1 rib st = 32 sts. and 23 rows.

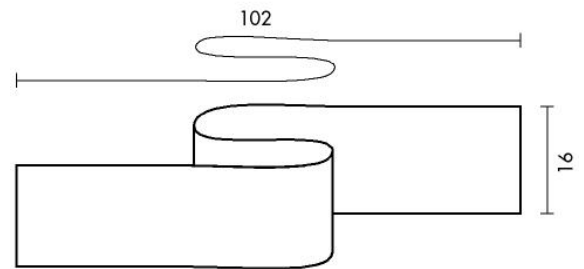
WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Scarf: Working with the knitting needles and with the orange yarn cast on 51 sts. and work in k1/p1 rib st. then work measures 102 cm. bind off all the sts.

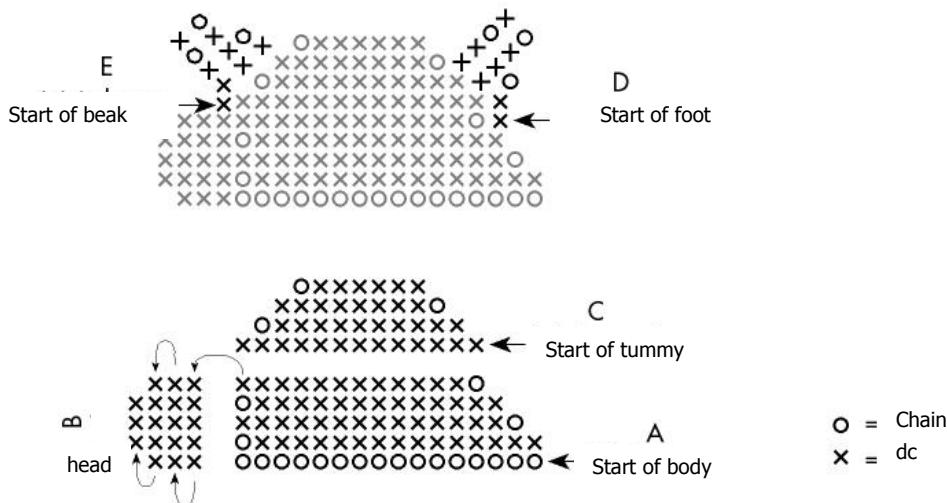
Penguins: work with the crochet hook following the chart and working the back with the back yarn, the tummy with the white yarn, the beak and feet with the orange yarn. Work 2 penguins in the same way.

MAKING UP AND FINISHING

Sew on penguins at 13 cm. from a short side of the scarf, placing them at the centre width-wise and overlapping them by 1 cm. (see photo). Embroider the eyes with 2 small long stitches with the white yarn. With the orange yarn make 2 pompons with diameter of 8 cm. Gather the short sides of the scarf pulling the edge stitches closely. Sew the pompons at the ends of the scarf.



Penguin Chart



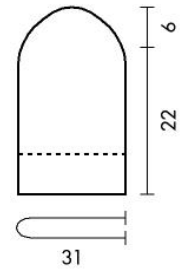
CAP

YARN

Adriaafil Yarns

MATERIALS

80 g orange no. 50 **Merino** yarn; several grams of the same yarn in white no. 02 and black no. 01
 Knitting needles no. 31/2 and no. 5
 Crochet hook no. 4.50
 Tapestry needle



DIMENSIONS: the circumference is 31 cm.

PATTERN STITCHES

K1/p1 rib, Chain stitch, Double crochet, Long stitch

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm. work with knitting needles no. 5 in k1/p1 rib st = 32 sts. and 23 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Cap: with knitting needles no. 31/2 and with the orange yarn cast on 99 sts. and work 4 rows in elastic rib. Cont. with knitting needles no. 5 in k1/p1 rib st starting con k1. When work measures 22 cm. space 24 decreases as follows: work * k1, p1, slip 1, k1, pass slipped st over *, rep. from * to *, another 23 times, then complete the row; cont. working the sts as they are; When work measures 5 cm. from decreases, (work k1, then k2 tog. for the whole row, work the return row) twice. Break off the yarn leaving a long length, and threading it through remaining sts, gather all the stitches closely, bind off on back of work with small stitches, then cont. with the seam on the side edges.

Penguins: work with the crochet hook following the chart and working the back with the back yarn, the tummy with the white yarn, the beak and feet with the orange yarn. Work 2 penguins in the same way.

MAKING UP AND FINISHING

Fold the bottom edge of the cap on the right of work for 6 cm. and tack. Sew on penguins at the centre of the edge and width-wise and overlapping them by 1 cm. (see photo). Embroider the eyes with 2 small long stitches with the white yarn. Remove the tacking. With the orange yarn make 1 pompon with a diameter of 8 cm. and sew it on at the top of the cap
