



OUTFIT "NILO"

Yarn MOHAIR STRETCH

Pull

YARN

Adriafil Yarns

MATERIALS

150 g Mohair Stretch yarn in violet no. 43; several g. of the same yarn in lilac no. 33

Knitting needles no. 51/2

Crochet hook no. 2.50

Tapestry needle

SIZE: 38 (40-42)

PATTERN STITCHES

Knitted stitch, Chain stitch, Double crochet, Half treble crochet, Treble crochet, Double treble crochet

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm. work with knitting needles no. 51/2 in knitted st = 16.5 sts. and 28 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

The pullover is decorated with 7 roses.

Back: working with the knitting needles and with the violet yarn cast on 60 (66-72) sts. and work in knitted st. To shape the sides decr. at the

ends 1 st every 20 rows twice; when work measures 23 (24-25) cm. incr. at the ends 1 st every 10 rows twice. When work measures 33 (35-37) cm., to shape the sleeve holes bind off at the ends, every 2 rows, 2 sts, 1 st.; when work measures 19 cm. from beg. of sleeve holes, to shape the shoulder slant bind off at the ends, every 2 rows, 6 sts, 5 sts twice (6 sts 3 times - 7 sts. twice, 6 sts). When work measures 2 cm. from beg. of the shoulder slant bind off the 22 (24-26) remaining sts.

Front: work like the back until work measures 10 (11-12) cm. For opening, bind off the 2 centre sts and end the two parts separately. At the same time shape the sides, work the sleeve holes and slant the shoulders in the same way as back. When work measures 20 (21-22) cm. for the neckline decr. centrewise 1 st every 6 rows 6 (7-8) times, 1 st every 10 rows 4 times.

Sleeves: working with the knitting needles and with the violet yarn cast on 44 (48-52) sts. and work in knitted st. At the ends decr. 1 st every 8 rows 5 times. Cont. without variations until work measures 17 cm., then incr. at the ends 1 st every 14 rows 5 times. When work measures 43 (45-47) cm., to shape the sleeve holes cross off at the ends, every 2 rows, 3 sts, 2 sts twice, then 1 st every 4 rows 9 (10-11) times. When work measures 16 cm. from beg. of sleeve holes, bind off the 12 (14-16) remaining sts.

Rose: with the crochet hook and with the .rst colour cast on a 6 stitch chain, making a loop with 1 dc in the .rst ch and, in the loop obtained, work:

Row 1: (.rst colour) 24 trs; end this row and the next rows with 1 dc in the starting st.

Row 2: (second colour) * 1 dc, 4 chs, skip 3 sts. *, rep. from * to *.

Row 3: (second colour) in each loop below work 1 dc, 1 half tr, 3 trs, 1 half tr, 1 dc

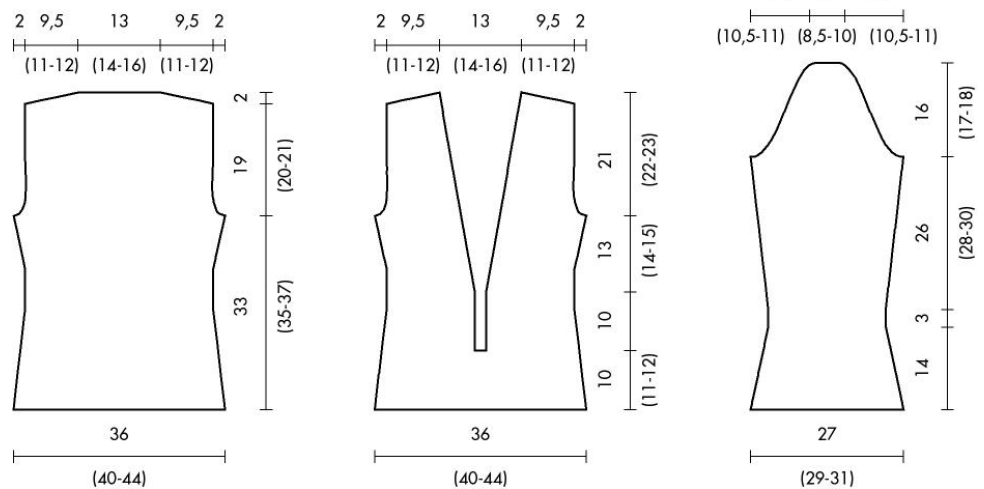
Row 4: (.rst colour) * 1 half tr passing with the crochet hook around the dc of the 2nd row, 4 chs *, rep. from * to *.

Row 5: (.rst colour) in each loop below work 1 dc, 1 half tr, 2 trs, 2 d trs, 2 trs, 1 half tr, 1 dc

Break off and bind the yarn.

Work in the same way another 6 roses alternating the colours as follows:

- **4 roses:** casting row and row 1, violet, rows 2 and 3 lilac, rows 4 and 5 violet (A)
- **1 rose:** casting row and row 1 lilac, rows 2 and 3 violet, rows 4 and 5 lilac (B)
- **2 roses:** casting row and rows 1, 2 and 3 lilac, rows 4 and 5 violet (C)



MAKING UP AND FINISHING

Sew on the shoulders and the sides. Join and mount the sleeves. With the crochet hook and with the violet yarn trim the neckline as follows:

Row 1: work in double crochet.

Row 2: * 1 dc, skip 2 sts, in the next st work 5trs, skip 2 sts *, rep. from * to *; at the same time, join the base of the neckline with 1 dc between the two sides of the trim.

Break off and bind the yarn.

In the same way trim the bottom of the sleeves.

Sew on 1 rose "A" at 7 (8-9) cm from the base of the neckline, 4 roses (3 "A" and 1 "B") on the left of the front arranging them in a diamond pattern (see photo) and centring them at the height of the sleeve hole. Sew 1 rose "C" at the centre of each sleeve, at 2 cm. from the bottom.

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MATERIALS

50 g **Mohair Stretch** yarn in lilac no. 33

Knitting needles no. 51/2

Crochet hook no. 2.50

Tapestry needle

SIZE: 38 (40-42)

PATTERN STITCHES

Knitted stitch, Chain stitch, Double crochet, Treble crochet

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm. work with knitting needles no. 51/2 in knitted st = 16.5 sts. and 28 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: with the knitting needles cast on 60 (66-72) sts. and work in knitted st. To shape the sides decr. at the ends 1 st every 10 rows 3 times. Cont. without other variations until work measures 31 (33-35) cm., then cross off the sts

Front: work like the back.

MAKING UP AND FINISHING

Sew up the sides. With the crochet hook trim the upper edge as follows:

Row 1: work in double crochet.

Row 2: * 1 dc, skip 2 sts, in the next st work 5trs, skip 2 sts *, rep. from * to *.

Break off and bind the yarn.

Trim the bottom, back and front in the same way.

For the shoulder straps: hook the yarn along the upper edge of the top, at 7 cm. from a side, and work 3 trs, 1 ch and 1 tr in the same base st; * turn over work, 3 chs, in the space of 1 ch work 2 trs, 1 ch and 1 tr *, rep. from * to *; when work measures 35 (36-37) cm. of the shoulder strap hook the yarn with 1 dc in the opposite edge, at 7 cm from the same side; break off and bind the yarn. Work the other shoulder strap in the same way.
