



# PULL "MANITOBA"

Yarn BAROQUE

## YARN

Adriafil Yarns

## MATERIALS

400 g **Baroque** Yarn colour no. 60

Knitting needles no. 12

Double pointed auxiliary needle

Tapestry needle

**SIZE:** 44 (40-42)

## PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib (start and end), Knitted stitch, Cable stitch (work over 14 sts.):

**Row 1 and 3:** in knit st.

**Row 2 and next even rows:** in purl stitch.

**Row 5:** cross 14 elongated sts leftwise (= stand off 7 sts on auxiliary needle in front of work, work the next 7 sts in knit st, \* turn over work and purl over the 7 sts, turn over work, knit up the 7 sts again \*, rep. from \* to \* once more; pick up the standing sts and work in knit st, then rep. from \* to \* 3 times; in this way the cable will be soft and "raised" with respect to the basic work.

**Rows 7 and 9:** in knit st.

**Row 11:** rep. from row 1

Knit stitch to end the elastic rib.

## GAUGE

10 x 10 cm. work with knitting needles no.12 in cable st = 11 sts. and 10 rows.

## WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

**Back:** cast on 54 (50-52) sts. and work 2 rows in elastic rib. Cont. establishing the sts as follows: [3 (1-2) sts. in knitted st, 14 sts in cable st] 3 times, 3 (1-2) sts in knitted st. When work measures 26 (24-25) cm., to shape the sleeve holes cross off at the ends 2 sts. When work measures 16 (14-15) sts from beg. of sleeve holes, to shape the shoulder slant cross off at the ends, every 2 rows, 6 sts, 5 sts twice. When work measures 6 cm. from beg. of the shoulder slant stand off the 18 (14-16) remaining sts.

**Front:** work like the back until work measures 40 (38-39) cm. To shape the neckline stand off the 12 (8-10) centre sts and end the two parts separately binding off centrewise, every 2 rows, 2 sts, 1 st. When work measures 16 (14-15) cm. from beg. of sleeve holes slant the shoulders in the same way as back.

**Sleeves:** cast on 30 (26-28) sts. and work 2 rows in elastic rib. Cont. establishing the sts as follows: 8 (6-7) sts. in knitted st, 14 sts. in cable st, 8 (6-7) sts. in knitted st. At the ends incr. 1 st every 6 rows 5 times and work these new sts in knitted st. When work measures 34 (30-32) cm., to shape the sleeve holes cross off at the ends 2 sts every 2 rows 7 times. When work measures 14 cm. from beg. of sleeve holes cross off the 12 (8-10) remaining sts.

## MAKING UP AND FINISHING

Sew up a shoulder. Pick up 50 (46-48) sts around the neckline (including the standing sts) and work in k2/p2 rib st. for 15 cm.; work 2 rows in elastic rib, then bind the sts. with the tapestry needle. Sew up the other shoulder and the sides of the collar leaving the lapel. Sew up the sides. Join and mount the sleeves.
