

# PAG. 5 BAG "MONET"



## YARN ADRIAFIL YARNS

### MATERIALS

- 150 g. **Candy** yarn in brown 40
- crochet hook no. 7
- 140 cm 2.5 cm brown satin ribbon
- tapestry needle

### PATTERN STITCHES

Chain  
Single crochet  
Double crochet  
Half treble crochet  
Treble crochet

### GAUGE

10 x 10 cm worked in treble with crochet hook no. 7 = 12 sts. and 4 rows

### WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

**Back panel:** cast-on a chain of 17 sts. and work in dc starting every row with 3 chs that replace the first dc \* When work measures a total of 14 cm. (6 rows) do not break off the yarn, but cont working along the side of the 6 rows you have just finished and work 3 tr on the side of each of the last 5 rows and 2 tr along the side of the 1<sup>st</sup> row. Cont in tr \*, rep. from \* to \* again once. When work measures a total of 14 cm. (6 rows) break off and bind the yarn.

**Front panel:** work like the back panel.

**Handle:** cast-on a chain of 48 sts. and work 1 row in tr. Break off and bind the yarn.

**Pink:** cast-on a chain of 5 sts. and close with a loop with 1 sc

**Row 1:** in the loop obtained work 12 tr, end with 1 sc in the beg. st. of the row.

**Row 2:** 1 ch, point the hook in the initial loop, between the next 2 tr and work 1 dc, \* 3 chs, skip 2 tr, 1 dc in the initial loop \*, rep. from \* to \* again 4 times, 3 chs, skip 2 sts, end with 1 sc in the beg. st. of the row.

**Row 3:** 1 sc, in each 3 arch chain work: 1 dc, 1 half tr, 2 tr, 1 half tr and 1 dc end with 1 sc in the beg. st. of the row.

Break off and bind the yarn. Work another 2 rows in the same way.

### MAKE UP AND FINISH

Sew the back panel to the front panel, leaving open the upper edge (namely the upper edge of the 1<sup>st</sup> square and the right side of the 2<sup>nd</sup> square). Sew a pink rose at the middle of each square of the front panel. Braid the ribbon into the tr of the handle, picking up and skipping 2 tr, and between the sts. and the upper edge rows of the bag, Sew the end of the handle to the ends of the opening of the bag.
