

PAG. 10 JACKET "GAUDI"



YARN ADRIAFIL YARNS

MATERIALS

- 450 g **Knitcol** yarn in colour no. 49
- knitting needles no. 4
- 2 two-tip knitting needles
- matching 54 cm separable zipper
- tapestry needle

SIZE: 44 (42-46)

PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib (beg. and finish)

K2/P2 rib stitch

Knit stitch

Purl stitch

Cable (work over 2 sts.):

Row 1: knit up the 2nd stitch passing with the right knitting needle behind the 1st st. and, without dropping the sts from the knitting needle, knit up the 1st stitch.

Row 2: purl the 2nd stitch passing with the right knitting needle in front of the 1st st and, without dropping the sts from the knitting needle, purl the first stitch

Row 3: rep. from row 1

Right cable (work over 6 sts):

Row 1: k2, p2., k2

Row 2 and next even rows: p2., k2, p2.

Row 3: 6 sts crossed rightwise (= stand off 2 sts on a cable needle at back of work, stand off the next 2 sts. on a second cable needle at back of work, knit up the next 2 sts., take the 2 knitted stitches to the back of the 2 standing purled stitches, purl the purled stitches and knit up the last 2 standing stitches).

Rows 5 and 7: k2, p2., k2

Row 9: rep. from row 1

Left cable (work over 6 sts):

Row 1: k2, p2., k2

Row 2 and next even rows: p2., k2, p2.

Row 3: 6 sts crossed leftwise (= stand off 2 sts on a cable needle in front of work, stand off the next 2 standing stitches on a second cable needle at back of work, knit up the next 2 sts., purl the purled standing stitches and then knit up the last 2 standing stitches).

Rows 5 and 7: k2, p2., k2

Row 9: rep. from row 1

Knit stitch to finish of the elastic rib

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm worked in knit st or in purl with knitting needles 4 = 22 sts. and 30 rows
10 x 10 cm work the different stitches with knitting needles 4 = 25 sts. and 30 rows

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: cast on 122 (116-130) sts. and, for the edge, work 2 rows in elastic rib and 18 rows K1/P1 rib st, equal to a total of 6 cm. Cont in knit st decreasing 22 (20-24) sts evenly over the first row. To shape the sides inc. at ends 1 st. every 20 rows 3 times. When work measures 25 (24-26) cm. from the edge, to shape the armholes cross off at ends 4 sts, then dec., inside 2 sts, 2 sts every 4 rows 4 times. When work measures 17 (16-18) cm. from beg. of the armholes, to shape the shoulder slant cross off at ends, every 2 rows, 10 (9-11) sts, 9 (9-10) sts. Stand off the 44 (42-46) rem. stitches.

Right front: cast on 67 (65-69) sts. and, for the edge, work 2 rows in elastic rib, then establish the sts as follows: 3 edge sts., p2, 2 sts for the cable, p2, 6 sts for the right cable, p2, 2 sts for the cable, 48 (46-50) sts, K1/P1 rib st starting with p2. When work measures a total of 6 cm. establish the sts and the decs as follows: work the first 19 sts following the stitches established below, work 18 (17-19) sts in purl (space 6 decs evenly), then work 18 (17-19) sts in knit st (space 6 decs evenly). Leftwise to shape the side, work the armhole and slant the shoulder in same way as back. When work measures 44 (42-46) cm. from the edge stand off the 27 (26-27) rem. stitches.

Left front: work to match the right front, but working the cable leftwise instead of rightwise.

N.B. to obtain the same line effect as the right front, beg. work starting from the same part of the ball of yarn (namely, from the same colour shade of the yarn) where you started the right front.

Sleeves: cast on 70 (68-72) sts. and, for the edge, work 2 rows in elastic rib and 28 rows in K1/P1 rib st, equal to a total of 9 cm. Cont decreasing 12 sts evenly over the first row. and establish the sts as follows: 2 (1-3) sts in purl, 2 sts for the cable, p2, 10 sts in knit st, p2, 2 sts for the cable, 18 sts in purl, 2 sts for the cable, p2, 10 sts in knit st, p2, 2 sts for the cable, 2 (1-3) sts in purl At ends inc. 1 st. every 10 rows 5 times, 1 st. every 8 rows 6 times and work these new sts in knit st. When work measures 34 (33-35) cm. from the edge, to shape the armholes cross off at ends, every 2 rows, 4 sts, 3 sts twice, then dec., inside 2 sts, 2 sts every 4 rows 8 times, 2 sts every 2 rows twice, 4 sts Cross off the 12 (10-14) rem. stitches.

N.B. to obtain the same line effect on both sleeves, beg. work for each starting from the same point of the ball of yarn (namely, from the same colour shade of the yarn).

MAKE UP AND FINISH

Sew up the shoulder. Pick up 108 (104-112) sts around the neckline (including the standing stitches); work the first and the last 19 sts following the stitches established below for each front and work the remaining centre sts in K1/P1 rib st starting with p2. When work measures a total of 3,5 cm. from the neck work 4 rows in elastic rib, then sew over the stitches. Sew up the sides. End and join on the sleeves. Sew on the zipper.
