

# PAG 25 OUTFIT "MODIGLIANI"



## YARN ADRIAFIL YARNS

### MATERIALS

- A total of 300 g. of **Mohair Stretch** yarn subdivided as follows: 250 g. pink 03 and 50 g brown 15
- knitting needles no. 4
- crochet hook no. 3
- tapestry needle
- 120 cm 3.5 cm. brown velvet ribbon

**SIZE:** 40 (42-44)

### PATTERN STITCHES

Knit stitch

Chain

Single crochet

Double crochet

Half treble crochet

Treble crochet

Bobble stitch: 3 chs and 1 dc in the base st.

Fancy stitch (work over a multiple of 7 + 2 sts):

**Row 1:** 1 tr in the base st (replace the tr at the beg. of row with 3 chs), 1 tr in the next st., \* skip 2 sts, in the next st. work: 2 tr, 2 chs and 2 tr; skip 2 sts, 2 tr in the next 2 sts \*, rep. from \* to \*, turn

**Row 2 and all next rows:** \* 2 tr in the next 2 tr, in the next 2 ch arch work: 2 tr, 2 chs and 2 tr; skip 2 tr \*, rep. from \* to \* and end con 2 tr in the last 2 tr below, turn

### GAUGE

10 x 10 cm worked in knit st with knitting needles 4 = 18 sts. and 29 rows

### WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

**Back:** with the pink yarn cast on 70 (76-82) sts. and work in knit st dec. at ends 1 st. every 28 rows 4 times. When work measures a total of 68 (71-74) cm., to shape the armholes, cross off 4 sts at ends. When work measures 18 (19-20) cm. from armholes, to shape the shoulder slant cross off at ends, every 2 rows, 8 (9-10) sts. twice. When work measures 19 (20-21) cm. from beg. of the armholes cross off the 22 (24-26) rem. stitches to shape the neckline.

**Front:** with the pink yarn cast on 72 (78-84) sts. and work in knit st decreasing at ends 1 st. every 22 rows 5 times. When work measures a total of 61 (63-65) cm. cross off at ends, every 2 rows, 16 sts, 5 (7-9) sts, 2 sts 4 times. When work measures a total of 65 (67-69) cm. cross off the 4 (6-8) rem. stitches.

**Right cup:** with the pink yarn cast on 14 (15-16) m., work in knit st and inc. on right, every 2 rows, 2 sts 6 times, 1 st 4 times. When work measures a total of 8 (9-10) cm., to shape the armhole cross off leftwise 4 sts, then dec. 1 st. every 4 rows 5 times. When work measures a total of 9 (10-11) cm., to shape the neckline cross off on right, every 2 rows, 3 (4-5) sts, 2 sts 8 times. When work measures a total of 15 (16-17) cm. cross off the 2 rem. stitches.

**Left cup:** work to match the right cup.

**Right front:** with the pink yarn cast on 30 (32-34) sts. and work in knit st. Inc. leftwise 1 st after 20 rows and on right, 1 st. every 26 rows 3 times. When work measures a total of 14 (15-16) cm., to shape the armhole cross off leftwise, every 2 rows, 4 sts, 1 st. When work measures a total of 27 (29-31) cm., to shape the neckline cross off on right, every 2 rows, 5 sts, 3 sts, 2 sts twice, 1 st. When work measures a total of 32 (34-36) cm., for the shoulder, cross off leftwise, every 2 rows, 8 (9-10) sts twice.

**Left front:** work to match the right front.

**Sleeves:** with the pink yarn cast on 36 (38-40) sts. and work in knit st. Inc. at ends 1

st. every 20 rows 5 times. When work measures a total of 42 (43-44) cm., to shape the armholes cross off at ends 4 sts, then dec. 1 st. every 4 rows 8 (9-10) times, 2 sts every 2 rows 4 times. When work measures 15 (16-17) cm. from beg. of the armholes cross off the 6 rem. stitches.

### MAKE UP AND FINISH

Sew the cups on the front, working a centre a 1 cm deep centre tuck at the base of each cup, (remember that the seam at the base of the cup makes up the difference of 1 cm. between the length of the back and front). Trim the neckline and the armhole of each cup with 1 row in dc with the pink yarn, working 24 (25-26) sts along the side of the armhole, 25 (26-27) sts. along the side of the neckline and 4 (6-8) sts. over the 4 (6-8) crossed sts of the front. Break off and bind the yarn. Now work 7 tea roses to join to the front neckline.

**Tea rose:** with the brown yarn cast-on a chain of 8 sts. and close with a loop with 1 sc

**Row 1:** in the loop obtained work \* 1 dc, 3 tr \*, rep. from \* to \* again 4 times, end this row and all the next rows with 1 sc in the beg. st. of the row.

**Row 2:** 1 ch, \* 1 dc in the initial loop, on back of work, pointing the hook between the dc and the first dc of a petal of the prev. row, 3 chs \*, rep. from \* to \* again 4 times.

**Row 3:** 1 sc, in each of the next 5 ch arches work: 1 dc, 1 half tr, 3 tr, 1 half tr and 1 dc \*; when you are working the last 2 petals join, with the centre tr of each petal to the 1<sup>st</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> dc of the neckline, starting from the tip of the right cup (to join work as follows: after working a tr to join, slip the buttonhole off the hook, pointing it in the dc you are joining, pick up the slipped buttonhole and pass it through the dc).

Break off and bind the yarn. \* Work another tea rose and join it to the previous with the centre tr of the first free petal, skip 3 dc of the neckline edge, join the next petal to the next dc, skip 2 dc, join the next petal to the next dc \*, rep. from \* to \* again, once, work another tea rose and join it to the previous with the centre tr of the first free petal, skip 3 dc of the neckline edge, join the next petal to the next dc, skip 3 dc of the edge of the left cup, join the next petal to the next dc, rep. from \* to \* 3 times.

**Shoulder:** with the brown yarn work 3 tr, 2 chs and 1 tr in the centre tr of the first free petal of the tea rose at the top of the right cup (replace the tr at the beg. of row with 3 chs), \* turn, 1 sc in the tr, in the next 2 ch arch work: 3 tr, 2 chs and 1 tr \*, rep. from \* to \* again 6 times. Break off and bind the yarn. Work another shoulder in the same way at the centre tr of the first free petal of the tea rose at the top of the left cup.

Sew up the shoulder of the back to the shoulders of the front fitting the end of the shoulders in the seam, at 2 cm from the neckline. Trim the neckline and the opening of the front with 1 row in dc with the pink yarn.

**Collar:** with the pink yarn work 6 rows in fancy st. over the sts of the back neckline and on the first 7 (8-9) cm of the front neckline. Break off and bind the yarn.

Trim the opening of the front, the free neckline and the sides of the collar with 2 rows worked as follows:

**Row 1:** with the pink yarn work 4 dc in the first 4 sts of the opening of the left front then cont in fancy st. and end with 4 dc in the last 4 dc of the opening of the right front, turn

**Row 2:** with the brown yarn work 1 dc in the 1<sup>st</sup> dc, skip 2 sts, in the next st. work: 2 tr, 1 bobble and 2 tr; \* 1 dc in the space between the next 2 tr, in the next 2 ch arch work: 2 tr, 1 bobble and 2 tr; skip 2 tr \*, rep. from \* to \* over the row and end with 1 dc between the last 2 tr of the prev. row, in the next dc work: 2 tr, 1 bobble and 2 tr; 1 dc in the last dc below

Break off and bind the yarn.  
Cut the velvet ribbon into two 60 cm lengths. Sew the first 17 (18-19) cm of the strands at the bottom of each front. Sew up the sides of the outfit, fitting between the two layers of fabric the sides of the fronts. Sew the under part of the sleeves and join. Finish the bottom of the outfit and the sleeves with 4 rows worked as follows:

**Row 1:** with the pink yarn work 1 dc in each stitch of the knitted part, end this row and all the next rows with 1 sc in the beg. st. of the row.

**Rows 2 and 3:** work in fancy st.

**Row 4:** with the brown yarn work \* 2 dc in the 2 tr, in the next 2 ch arch work: 2 tr, 1 bobble and 2 tr; skip 2 tr \*, rep. from \* to \* over the row

Break off and bind the yarn.
