

# PAG. 9 PULLOVER "SUTHERLAND"



## YARN ADRIAFIL YARNS

### MATERIALS

- 250 g. **Kid mohair** yarn in aviation blue no. 80
- crochet hook no. 4.50
- tapestry needle

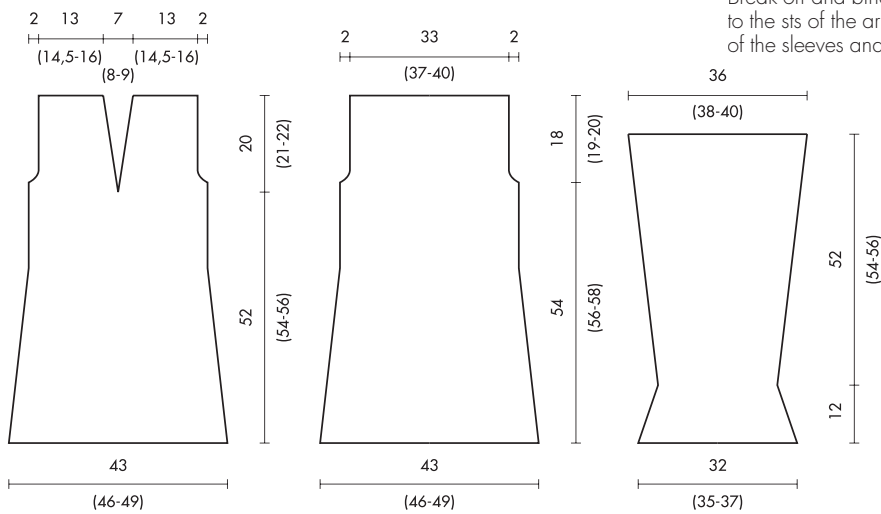
**SIZE:** 40 (42-44)

### PATTERN STITCHES

Chain  
Single crochet  
Double crochet  
Treble crochet  
Fancy stitch (work over a multiple of 6 + 1 stitches): follow the chart.

### GAUGE

10 x 10 cm work in fancy st. with crochet hook no. 4.50 = 17 sts. and 9 rows.



### WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

**Back:** cast-on a chain of 73 (79-85) st. + 1 to turn and work in fancy st. decreasing at ends 1 st. every 8 rows 5 times. When work measures a total of 54 (56-58) cm., to shape the armholes stand off work, at ends, over 3 sts. When work measures a total of 18 (19-20) cm. from armholes break off and bind the yarn.

**Front:** work in the same way as back until work measures a total of 52 (54-56) cm. To shape the neckline stand off work over centre st. and cont. over 2 parts separately decreasing again, centrewise, 1 st. every 3 rows 5 times (1 st. every 2 rows 6 times - 1 st. every 2 rows 7 times). At the same time, when work measures 54 (56-58) cm. shape the armholes in same way as back. When work measures a total of 2 (21-22) cm. from beg. of neckline break off and bind the yarn.

**Sleeves:** work picking up the sts. of the armholes. Sew up the shoulder. Pick up 61 (65-69) sts. around the armhole and work in fancy st. (for the other sizes work at ends 2-1 edge sts.). At ends dec. 1 st. every 2 rows 6 times, 1 st. every 4 rows 3 times. When work measures a total of 52 (54-56) csts inc. at ends 1 st. at every row 6 times. When work measures a total of 64 (66-68) cm. break off and bind the yarn.

### MAKE UP AND FINISH

Sew up the shoulder. Trim the neckline with 1 row of arches as follows: start from beg. of back neckline and work 1 dc, \* 10 chs., 1 dc in next arch \*, rep. from \* to \* along all the back neckline, \*\* 10 chs., skip 1 row of the front neckline, 1 dc in next row \*\*, rep. from \*\* to \*\* along front neckline and end the last repetition by not working the last dc and working 1 sc in the dc at beg. of row. Break off and bind the yarn. Sew up the sides. Sew up the first row of the sleeves to the sts of the armholes then sew the under part of the sleeves. Finish the bottom of the sleeves and the pullover with 1 row worked as follows: 1 dc, \* 10 chs., 1

dc in next arch \*, rep. from \* to \* over the row and end the last repetition by not working the last dc and working 1 sc in the dc at beg. of row. Break off and bind the yarn. For each lace cast-on a chain of 180 sts. and close with a loop with 1 sc. Break off and bind the yarn. Work another lace in the same way. Thread the laces into the sts of row 46 (48-50) of each sleeve and make a bow.
