YARN
ADRIAFIL YARNS

MATERIALS

- 150 g. **Genziana** yarn in cream no. 11
- knitting needles no. 31/2
- 3 white buttons
- 120 cm of 7 mm cream satin ribbon
- 4 small matching organza and satin rosettes
- tapestry needle

AGE: 12 months

PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib (ending)
Saw tooth edge (work over an uneven number of stitches and 10 rows):
from rows 1 to 4: in knit st
Row 5: k1, * 1 yo, k2 tog. *, rep. from * to *.
Row 6: purl stitch.
from rows 7 to 10: in knit st
K1/P1 rib stitch
Knit stitch
Openwork decorations (work over a multiple of 20 + 3 sts): follow the chart).
Openwork column (work over 3 sts):
Row 1: 1 yo, 1 double dec, 1 yo
Row 2: purl stitch.
Row 3: rep. from row 1
Knit stitch for the finish of the elastic rib

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm worked in knit st and in openwork columns with knitting needles 31/2 = 26 sts. and 35 rows

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: cast on 103 sts. and work the saw tooth edge, equal to a total of 4 cm. Cont in openwork decorations following the chart; at the end of the work, cont in openwork columns over the rem. 3 centre stitches of each decoration and work in knit st over all the rem. stitches. When work measures 24 cm. from the end of the edge work 1 row as follows: k2, * 1 yo, 1 double dec *, rep. from * to * another 32 times, k2; purl the return row then cont over all le rem. 70 stitches in knit st When work measures 2 cm. from the knitting needle, to shape the armholes cross off at ends 3 sts, then dec., inside 2 sts, 1 st. every 2 rows 3 times; at same time, to shape the opening cross off the 6 centre sts and end the two parts separately. When work measures 9 cm. from beg. of the opening, to shape the neckline cross off centrewise 10 sts, 2 sts after 2 rows, then cross off the 14 rem. stitches for each shoulder.
Front: work in the same way as back, excepting the opening, until work measures a total of 6.5 cm. from beg. of the armholes. To shape the neckline cross off the 16 centre sts and end the two parts separately; cross off again centrewise 3 sts after 2 rows, then




- 50 g **Genziana** yarn in cream no. 11
- knitting needles no. 31/2
- 35 cm of 7 mm cream satin ribbon
- 1 small matching organza and satin rosette
- tapestry needle

AGE: 12 months



PATTERN STITCHES

Saw tooth edge (work over an uneven number of stitches and 10 rows):
Rows 1 to 4: in knit st
Row 5: k1, * 1 yo, k2 tog. *, rep. from * to *.
Row 6: purl stitch.
Rows 7 to 10: in knit st
Knit stitch
Openwork decorations (work over a multiple of 20 + 3): follow the chart given for the dress).
Openwork column (work over 3 sts):
Row 1: 1 yo, 1 double dec, 1 yo
Row 2: purl stitch.
Row 3: rep. from row 1




- = k1

dec., inside 1 st, 1 st. every 2 rows 4 times. When work measures 3.5 cm. from beg. of neckline cross off the 14 rem. stitches for each shoulder.

Sleeves: cast on 39 sts. and work the saw tooth edge in same way as back. Cont working the 17 centre sts for the openwork decoration following the chart and all the rem. side stitches in knit st; at the end of the chart, cont. over the 3 centre sts del decoration with the openwork column and work in knit st over all the other side stitches. At same time, at ends inc. 1 st. every 6 rows 6 times. When work measures 12 cm. from the end of the edge, to shape the armholes cross off at ends, every 2 rows, 3 sts, 2 sts twice, then dec., inside 2 sts, 1 st. every 2 rows 13 times. When work measures 9 cm. from beg. of the armholes cross off the 11 rem. stitches.

MAKE UP AND FINISH

Sew up the shoulder. Pick up 27 sts along left side of the back opening and work in K1/P1 rib st working, over the 3rd row, 2 buttonholes the first of which inside the first 8 sts from the bottom, and the 2nd spaced by 11 sts; when work measures a total of 2 cm. work 4 rows in elastic rib, then sew over the stitches. Trim in the same way the right of the open section, not including the buttonholes. Pick up 89 sts around the neckline and work in K1/P1 rib st working, over the 3rd row, 1 buttonhole in the same position as the prev; when work measures a total of 2 cm. work 6 rows in elastic rib, then sew over the stitches. Sew up the sides. End and join on the sleeves. Fold back all the edges and sew them in with blind stitches. Sew the sides of the edges at the base of the back opening overlapping the left on the right. Sew the buttons along the right side of the opening, on the opposite side of the buttonholes. Brad the ribbon between the holes at the bottom of the bodice pulling it out in the middle of the front, the make a bow. Sew on the rosettes 2 cm from the ribbon spaced evenly.



GAUGE

10 x 10 cm worked in knit st and in openwork columns with knitting needles 31/2 = 26 sts. and 35 rows

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Cast on 103 sts. and work the saw tooth edge, equal to a total of 4 cm. Cont in openwork decorations following the chart; at the end cont in openwork columns over the 3 rem. centre sts of each motif and work in knit st over all the rem. stitches. When work measures 8.5 cm. from the end of the edge, space 16 decs only over the five 17 st. areas. work in knit st (work the openwork columns as before) as follows: slip 1, knit 1 pass slipped stitch over on the first 2 of the 17 sts. and k2 tog. on the last 2 sts; rep. these decs every 2 rows until 3 sts remain on each of the 5 zones. Then work 1 double dec on each group of 3 sts; work the return row normally, then work 1 row as follows: k1, k2 tog. 11 times. Break off the yarn leaving a long strand. Braid the yarn through the rem. stitches, then pull the yarn to gather all the sts. closely, join on back with tiny stitches, then cont with the seam side edges.

MAKE UP AND FINISH

Fold the saw tooth edge over and join in blind stitch. Tie the satin ribbon into a bow at the top of the hat.
