

Jumper Aldebaran



Actual size	31½ ins 80 cm	33ins 84cm	34½ins 98cm
Full Length	19½ins 50 cm	21ins 53 cm	22ins 56 cm

Materials

9 x 50g Sierra Andina
4mm (UK8) needles

Abbreviations

k knit
p purl
rs right side
ws wrong side
Pssso pass slipped stitch over
inc increase
tog together
sl1 slip one
st(s) stitch(es)
st - st stocking stitch (knit one row, purl one row)
tbl through back of loop
yb yarn back

Tension

24 sts and 28 rows to 10 cm or 4 ins worked on 4mm needles measured over stocking stitch.

Back

Using 4mm needles and thumb method, cast on 116(132, 150) sts
1st row K4, (4, 5)*p4, k4 repeat from * last 4(4, 5) sts, k to end
2nd row P4, (4, 5)*k4, p4 repeat from* last 4(4, 5) sts, p to end

Continue in rib pattern as set until work measures 35 (37, 39) cm 14(14½, 15½) ins ending with a ws row

Shape armhole

1st row K2, k3tog, tbl, work to last 5 sts, k3tog k2
2nd row pattern
Repeat the last two rows 3 (5,7) times 100 (108, 118) sts
Next row K2, k2tog, tbl, work to last 4 sts k2tog, k2
Next row pattern
Repeat the last two rows 5 more times.
(88(96,106) sts
Continue straight until work measures 9(10, 11) cm 3½(4, 4¼) ins from beginning of armhole shaping
Cast off

Front

Using 4mm needles and thumb method, cast on 124(140, 156) sts
First row k4, p4 to end
Next row p4, k4 to end
Continue in rib pattern until work measures 27(28, 29) cm 10½ (11, 11½)ins from beginning, ending with a WS row

Shape neckline

Keeping rib pattern correct
Next row Pattern 106(118, 130) sts, and put remaining 18 (22,26) sts on a stitch holder.
Working on these 106(118, 130) sts only
Next row Cast off 4sts, pattern to end
Next row pattern to end
Repeat the last 2 rows 5 more times
82(94, 106) sts
Next row (K2 tog) twice, cast off 2 sts, pattern to end.
Next row Pattern
Repeat these last two rows until work measures 8(9,10) cm from beginning of neck shaping, ending with a ws row

Shape armhole

Maintaining continuity of neck shaping as before,
1st row K2, k3tog, tbl, work to end
2nd row (K2 tog) twice, cast off 2 sts, pattern to end.
Repeat the last two rows 3 (5,7) times
Next row K2, k2tog, tbl,work to end
Next row (K2 tog) twice, cast off 2 sts, pattern to end.
Continue decreases as set until 2 sts remain. Work straight on these sts until armhole measures the same as the back.
Cast off

Right front

Rejoin yarn to neck edge of right front

Work in pattern to end of row.

Continue in rib pattern as set until work measures 8(9,10) cm from beginning of neck shaping ending with a ws row

Shape armhole

1st row work to last 5 sts, k3tog k2

2nd row pattern

Repeat the last two rows 3 (5,7) more

Next row work to last 4 sts k2tog, k2

Next row pattern

Repeat the last two rows 5 more times.

Continue straight until work measures 9(10, 11) cm 3½(4, 4¼) ins from beginning of armhole shaping
Cast off

Sleeves

Using 4mm needles and thumb method, cast on 64(69, 74) sts and work 21(22, 23) cm 8¼ (8¾, 9) ins in stocking stitch ending with rs row.

Next row increase 2(5, 8) sts evenly across the row
66(74, 82) sts

Next row k2 *p2, k2 to end.

Next row p2 *k2, p2 to end

Keeping rib pattern correct, increase 1 st at each end of the 6th and every following 8th row, 8 times
82(90, 98) sts.

Continue without shaping until work measures 50 (52, 54) cm 19¾(20½,21¼) ins from beginning, ending with a ws row.

Shape armholes

1st row K2, k3tog tbl, work to last 5 sts, k3tog, k2.

2nd row Pattern to end

Repeat the last 2 rows 2(3, 4) times 70 (74, 78) sts

Next row K2, K2tog tbl, work to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2.

Repeat the last 2 rows 5 times more 58 (62, 66) sts

Work 4 rows straight

Decrease 4 sts at the beginning of the next 8 rows
26(30, 38)

Decrease 6 sts at beginning of the next 2 rows

14(18,22) sts

Cast off

Collar

Using 4mm needles cast on 68(72, 76) sts and work in pattern as follows

1st row K1, yfwd, sl1 purlwise, yb k 1(3,5) *P2, K2

repeat from * to last 1(3,5) sts purl to end

2nd row K1(3,5) *p2, k2 repeat from * to last 3(5,7) sts p1(3,5)k1, yfwd, sl1.

Keeping pattern correct work straight until collar measures 110(113,116) cm 43(44½, 45½) ins.

Cast off in pattern

To make up

Sew together the shoulder seams, matching the 2sts of the fronts to the outside edges of the back. Sew the sleeves in place and join the sleeve and side seams.

Join the long edge of the collar to the neck edge overlapping at the front. Sew the two short edges in place.
