# **SCARF**

# YARN ADRIAFIL YARNS

#### **MATERIALS**


- 100 g. Stella Alpina yarn in brown 61, doubled
- crochet hook no. 8

#### **PATTERN STITCHES**

Chain Double crochet

# **GAUGE**

 $10 \times 10$  cm. work in dc. with the yarn doubled and crochet hook 8 = 10 sts. and 11,5 rows



#### **WORKING INSTRUCTIONS**

The scarf measures 14x64 cm.

With the yarn doubled cast on a 14 st. chain + 1 to turn.

**Row 1:** 1 dc. in the second ch. from the hook, 13 dc. in the next 13 sts., turn with 1 ch.

**Row 2 and all the next rows.:** 14 dc. in the 14 sts. below, turn with 1 ch.

When work measures a total of 15 cm., for the opening divide the work in half, cont. over the 2 parts separately for 8 rows, then cont. working over all the 14 sts. When work measures a total of 64 cm. break off and bind the yarn.

# **HAT**

## YARN ADRIAFIL YARNS

# **MATERIALS**

- a total of 120 g. Stella Alpina yarn doubled consisting of 100 g. brown yarn 61 and 20 g. cream 11
- 10 g. Globe Uni yarn in beige 40
- crochet hook no. 8

SIZE: 8 years

# **PATTERN STITCHES**

Chain

Double crochet

Reverse stitch: work like dc. from left to right.

# <u>40</u> <u>48</u> <u>48</u>

#### GAUGE

 $10 \times 10$  cm. work in dc. with the yarn doubled and crochet hook 8 = 10.5 sts. and 11.5 rows.

### **WORKING INSTRUCTIONS**

Hat: with the brown yarn doubled cast on an 11 st. chain and close in a loop with 1 sc. (decorative look at the top of hat),

**Row 1:** 2 chs., in the second ch. from the hook work 8 dc.; cont. in rounds without closing the work at the end of the rows

Row 2: \* 1 dc. in the next st., 2 dcs. in the next st. \*, rep. from \* to \* again 3 times.

**Row 3:** \* 1 dc. in the next st., 2 dcs. in the next st. \*, rep. from \* to \* again 5 times.

**Row 4:** \* 2 dcs. in the next 2 sts., 2 dcs. in the next st. \*, rep. from \* to \* again 5 times.

**Row 5:** \* 2 dcs. in the next 2 sts., 2 dcs. in the next st. \*, rep. from \* to \* again 7 times.

**Row 6:** \* 3 dc. in the next 3 sts., 2 dcs. in the next st. \*, rep. from \* to \* again 7 times.

Rows 7 and 8: work 1 dc. in each of the 40 sts. below

Row 9: \* 7 dc. in the next 7 sts., 2 dcs. in the next st. \*, rep. from \* to \* again 4 times.

Row 10: \* 8 dc. in the next 8 sts., 2 dcs. in the next st. \*, rep. from \* to \* again 4 times.

from rows 11 to 18: 1 dc. in each of the 50 sts. below

**Row 19:** \* 9 dc. in the next 9 sts., skip 1 st. \*, rep. from \* to \* again 4 times.

Row 20: \* 14 dc. in the next 14 sts., skip 1 st. \*, rep. from \* to \* again twice.

Row 21: 1 dc. in each of the 42 sts. below

Row 22:in reverse st.

Break off and bind the yarn.

**Decoration**: two flowers each with 5 petals and 1 centre.

**Petal**: with the cream yarn doubled cast on an 8 st. chain.

**Row 1:** 1 dc. in the second ch. from the hook, 1 dc. in each of the next 5 chs., 3 dc. in the next ch., cont. on the opposite side of the starting ch. and work 1 dc. in each of the next 5 chs., 2 dcs. in the next ch., end with 1 sc. in the first chain. of the row. Break off and bind the yarn.

Work another 9 petals in the same way.

**Centre of the flower**: with the beige yarn cast on a 5 st. chain, and close in a loop with 1 sc. and, in the loop obtained, work 12 dcs.; end with 1 sc. in the first st. of the row.

Break off and bind the yarn. Work another pistil in the same way.

### **MAKE UP AND FINISH**

Following the picture, sew the petals onto the hat shaping the 2 flowers next to each other. Sew the centre of the flowers at the point where the petals join.
