



"MACUGNAGA" CARDIGAN

MATERIALS

- 1 kg. **Perù** yarn in colour no. 91
- knitting needles nos. 31/2 and 4
- tapestry needle

SIZE: 48 (44-46)

PATTERN STITCHES

K1/p1 rib stitch
Knitted stitch
Purled stitch


GAUGE

10x10 cm. using knitting needles no. 4 work in knit st. = 22 sts. and 29 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: with knitting needles no. 4 cast on 123 (111-117) sts. and, for the border, work 10 rows in knit stitch. and 4 rows in k1/p1 rib st., equal to a total of 5 cm. Cont. in knit stitch. To shape the sides, when work measures 26 (22-24) cm. from border decr. at ends 1 st. every 10 rows 5 times; When work measures 47 (45-46) cm. from border incr. at ends 1 st. every 6 rows 5 times. When work measures 60 (54-57) cm. from border, to shape the armholes decr. at ends, inside 4 sts., 2 sts. every 2 rows 3 times, 2 sts. every 4 rows 4 (2-3) times. At 18 (16-17) cm. from beg. of the armholes, to shape the neckline cross off the 33 (29-31) centre sts. and end the two parts separately; cross off again centrewise, every 2 rows, 5 sts., 3 sts. twice, 2 sts. twice. At the same time, at 1 cm. from beg. of the neckline, to slant the shoulders cross off at ends 4 sts. every 2 rows 4 times.

Right front: with knitting needles no. 4 cast on 43 (39-41) sts. and work the border in same way as back. Cont. in knit stitch. Leftwise shape the side in same way as back. When work measures 60 (54-47) cm. from border, to shape the armhole cross off leftwise 3 sts., then decr., inside 4 sts., 2 sts. every 2 rows 3 times, 2 sts. every 4 rows 3 times (for the supplementary sizes decr. 2 sts. every 2 rows 3 times and 2 sts. every 4 rows twice - 2 sts. every 2 rows 3 times, 2 sts. every 4 rows twice and 1 st. after another 4 rows). When work measures 22 (20-21) cm. from beg. of the armhole cross off the 28 (26-27) rem. sts. for the shoulder.



Left front: work to match the right front.

Right sleeve: with knitting needles no. 4 cast on 51 (45-47) sts. and for the border, work 8 rows in knit stitch. and 10 rows in k1/p1 rib st., equal to 6.5 cm. Cont. in knit stitch. increasing 14 (10-12) sts. evenly in the first row. At ends incr. 1 st. every 14 rows 7 times. When work measures 37 (33-35) cm. from the border, to shape the armholes continue as follows: on right of work cross off 5 sts., then decr., inside 3 sts., 2 sts. alternatively every 2 rows and every 4 rows for a total of 6 times (= 12 decr.), 2 sts. every 4 rows 8 (6-7) times (= a total of 33-29-31 decr.); leftwise decr., inside 3 sts., 2 sts. alternatively every 2 rows and every 4 rows 8 times (= 16 decr.), 2 sts. every 4 rows 7 (5-6) times (= a total of 30-26-28 decr.). At 18 (16-17) cm. from beg. of the armholes cross off the 16 (14-14) rem. sts.

Left sleeve: work to match the right sleeve.

Right shoulder: with knitting needles no. 4 cast on 20 (18-19) sts. and work in knit stitch. decreasing leftwise (= back of shoulder), inside 5 sts., 1 st. every 4 rows 5 times. At the same time, when work measures 6 cm. cross off on right of work 7 sts. at 7 cm. cross off the 8 (6-7) rem. sts. (= side of collar).

Left shoulder: work to match the right shoulder.

Border: with knitting needles no. 31/2 cast on 25 sts. and work in knit stitch. for 4 cm. Cont. ins follows: work the first 5 sts. in purl st. and the next 20 sts. in k1/p1 rib st. starting with k1 and increasing 19 sts. in row 1. (= work 2 sts. in each of the first 19 sts. and 1 st. in the last st.). When work measures 214 (202-208) cm. decr. 19 sts. only between the sts. worked in k1/p1 rib st. and cont. over 25 rem. sts. in knit stitch. After 4 cm cross off all the sts.

Belt: with knitting needles no. 31/2 cast on 25 sts. and work 3 sts. in knit stitch., 19 sts. in k1/p1 rib st. starting with p1 and k3. At 185 (165-175) cm. cross off all the sts. knitting them up in twos.

MAKE UP AND FINISH

Sew up the edge with decreases on the shoulders to the shoulders of the back. Sew up the shoulder of each front to the opposite edge of the shoulder working along the shoulder of each front 2 pleats in order to even off the two sizes. Sew up the border, leaving the border in purl st. turned outwards, along the buttonhole sides of each front, along the edge of the shoulders and along the back neckline. Sew up the sides. Sew up and join the sleeves evening off the top of the latter with the base of the shoulders.
