



"DOBBIACO" PONCHO

BUCANEVE e **CHARME** yarns

YARN
ADRIAFIL YARNS

MATERIALS

- 350 g. **Bucaneve** yarn in wine red no. 57
- 100 g. **Charme** yarn in wine red no. 72
- knitting needles no. 41/2
- tapestry needle

SIZE: 46 (42-44)

PATTERN STITCHES

Knitted stitch
Garter stitch

GAUGE

10x10 cm. using knitting needles no. 41/2 and the Bucaneve yarn work in knit st. = 18,5 sts. and 25 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Back: with the Bucaneve yarn cast on 110 (94-102) sts. and work in knit stitch. When work measures 19 (17-18) cm., to shape the shoulders decr. at ends, inside 3 sts. and every 2 rows, alternatively 1 sts. and 2 sts., for a total of 30 (26-28) decreases for each shoulder. When work measures 16 (14-15) cm. from beg. of the decreases cross off the 50 (42-46) rem. sts.

Front: work in the same way as back.

Hood: with the Bucaneve yarn cast on 73 (63-68) sts. and work 70 (60-65) sts. in knit stitch. and 3 sts. in garter st. for the outer border. When work measures 75 (71-73) cm. cross off all the sts.

MAKE UP AND FINISH

Sew up the side edges of the back and of the front. Fold the hood in half and sew up the inner edge. Sew up the hood around the back and front neckline as follows: leave the side seam at the back in the middle and sew the base of the hood overlapping the extra parts along the front seam. With the Charme yarn work the fringes: braid the yarn through the end sts. of the poncho leaving loops of about 25 cm; braid the yarn in and out every 2 end stitches. Finally, trim off the loops by pulling the yarn and knotting them in twos to bind off the fringe.
