

## Pullover Pila



Actual size	34½ ins 88 cm	36ins 92cm	38ins 96cm
Back Length	25ins 64 cm	27ins 68 cm	28½ins 72 cm

### Materials

10x 50g balls Mistero  
1pair 5mm (6UK) needles  
1pair 6mm (4UK ) needles  
30cm (12") zip

### Tension

14 sts and 17½ rows to 10 cm or 4 ins worked on 6mm needles measured over stocking stitch.

### Abbreviations.

k knit  
p purl  
st(s) stitch(es)  
st-st stocking stitch

### Back

Using 5mm needles cast on 71(75, 81) sts and work 6 rows in k1 p1 rib  
Change to 6mm needles and work in st-st until back measures 35 cm (14 ins)

### Shape sides

Next row K2, k2tog, k to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2.  
Work 7 rows  
Repeat the last 8 rows twice more 65(69, 75) sts\*\*  
Continue straight until work measures 45(48, 51) cm 17¾(19, 20) ins. from beginning ending with a ws row.

### Shape armholes

Cast off 3 sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows.  
Decrease 1 st at each end of the next 2(3,4) rows 55 (57, 61) sts  
Continue straight until work measures 16(17,18)cm 6¼(6¾, 7) ins from beginning of armhole shaping.

### Shape shoulder

Cast off 15(16, 17) sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows 25, (25, 27)sts  
Work straight until collar measures 16 cm (6¼ins.)  
Cast off

### Front

Work as for back until \*\* is reached  
Continue straight until work measures 40 (43, 46) cm 15 ¾ (17, 18) ins, ending with a ws row.

### Neck shaping and armhole shaping

#### Next row

Work 32(34, 37) sts. Turn and complete this side of neck shaping first.

Work straight until front measures 45(48, 51) cm 17¾(19, 20) ins. from beginning ending with a ws row.

### Armhole shaping

Cast off 3 sts at the beginning of the next row.  
Work one row  
Decrease 1 st at beginning of next 2(3, 4) alternate rows 27(28, 30) sts  
Work straight until front measures 49 (52,55)cm 19¼(20½, 21½) ins ending with a ws row.  
**Next row** knit to last 2 sts increase in next st, k1.  
Work 5rows.  
Repeat the last 6 rows 3 times more.  
Work straight until armhole measure 16(17, 18) cm 6¼(6¾, 7) ins

### Shape shoulder

Cast off 15(16,17) sts at beginning of next row  
Continue straight on remaining 16(16, 17) sts until collar measures same as for back.  
Cast off

### Left front

Rejoin yarn to neck edge of stitches on stitch holder. Cast off 1 stitch, work to end.  
Complete to match left side, reversing all shapings

### Sleeves

Using 5mm needles, cast on 27(29, 31) sts and work 6 rows in k1, p1 rib.  
Change to 6mm needles, and working in st-st, increase 1<sup>st</sup> at each end of the 6<sup>th</sup> and every following 6 rows to 47(49, 51)sts, then at each end of the 4<sup>th</sup> row 49(51, 53) sts  
Work straight until sleeve measures 35(37, 39) cm 13½(14½, 15½) ins from beginning ending with a ws row.  
Cast off

### Belt

Cut 30 strands of yarn each 450cm long. Knot them together about 7cm from the end. Divide them into three, and plait them  
Tie the other end of the plait together.  
If needed, trim the ends.

### To make up

Sew together the shoulder seams and the sides of the collar. Sew in the sleeves and join the sleeve and side seams. Sew zip into the front opening. Fold the collar in half into the inside and slip stitch in place.
