



"SELVA" PULLOVER

Kid Mohair yarn

YARN

ADRIAFIL YARNS

MATERIALS

- 300 g. **Kid Mohair** yarn, wound double, blue no. 10
- knitting needles nos. 3, 3 1/2, 5 and 6
- tapestry needle

SIZE: 44 (42-46)

PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib (start)

K1/p1 rib stitch

Knitted stitch

Reverse stitch

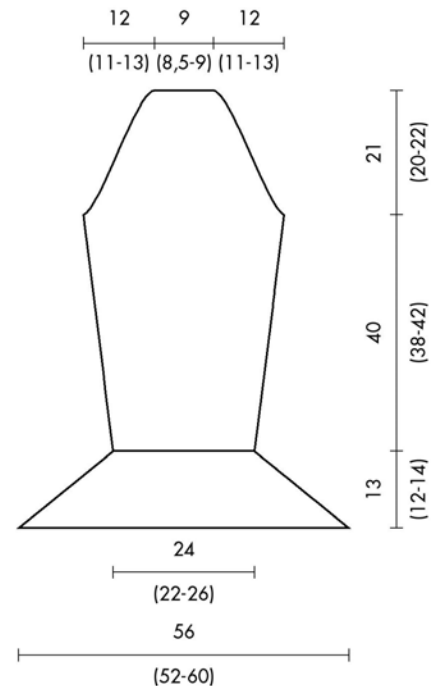
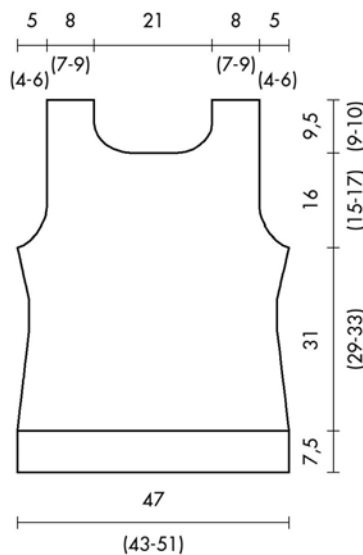
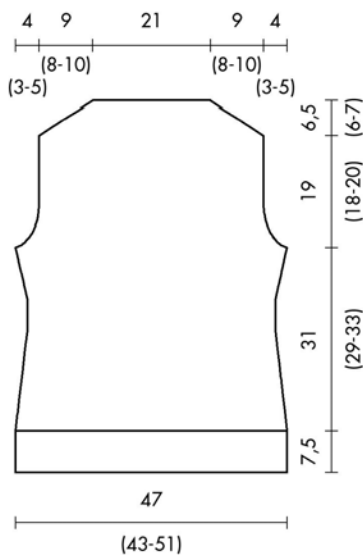
GAUGE

10x10 cm. using knitting needles no. 3 1/2 and the yarn wound double work in knit stitch. = 24 sts. and 32 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

N.B. Work with the yarn wound double.

Back: with knitting needles no. 3 cast on 109 (101-117) sts. and for the border, work 2 rows in elastic rib and 30 rows in k1/p1 rib st., equal to 7.5 cm. Cont. with knitting needles no. 3 1/2 in knit stitch. increasing 4 sts. in row 1. To shape the sides decr. at ends, inside 4 sts., 2 sts. every 10 row, 3 times; When work measures 17 (16-18) cm. from border incr. at ends 1 st. every 6 rows, 6 times. When work measures 31 (29-33) cm. from border, to shape the armholes decr. at ends, inside 4 sts., 2 sts. every 4 rows, 5 (4-6) times. When work measures 19 (18-20) cm. from beg. of the armholes, to slant the shoulders decr. at ends, inside 4 sts., 1 st. every 2 rows 11 (10-12) times and, at the same time, cross off at ends 1 st. every 2 rows 11 (10-12) times. When work measures 6.5 (6-7) cm. from beg. of the shoulder slant cross off the 49 rem. sts.



Front: work in same way as back until work measures 31 (29-33) cm. from border. To shape the armholes cross off at ends 4 sts., then decr., inside 4 sts., 2 sts. every 4 rows 4 (3-5) times, 1 st. after another 4 rows. When work measures 16 (15-17) cm. from beg. of the armholes, to shape the neckline cross off the 27 centre sts. and end the two parts separately; cross off again centrewise, every 2 rows, 3 sts., 2 sts. twice, 1 st. 4 times. When work measures 9,5 (9-10) cm. from beg. of the neckline cross off the 19 (17-21) rem. sts. for each shoulder.

Sleeves: with knitting needles no. 6 cast on 70 (65-74) sts. and for the border, work 2 rows in elastic rib, then cont. in knit stitch. decreasing at ends 1 st. every 4 rows 6 times; at the same time, when work measures 7 cm. cont. with knitting needles no. 5. When work measures 13 (12-14) cm. cont. with knitting needles no. 3 1/2. At ends incr. 1 st. every 10 rows 11 times. When work measures 40 (38-42) cm. from border, to shape the armholes cross off at ends 5 sts., then decr., inside 3 sts., 2 sts. every 6 rows 8 times, 2 sts. every 4 rows 4 (3-5) times. When work measures 21 (20-22) cm. from beg. of the armholes cross off the 22 (21-22) rem. sts.

Collar: with knitting needles no. 6 cast on 160 (150-170) sts., work 2 rows in elastic rib, then cont. in knit stitch. When work measures 20 (18-22) cm. cont. with knitting needles no. 5. When work measures 24 cm. cont. with knitting needles no. 3 1/2. When work measures 26 (25-27) cm. cont. in elastic rib for 10 rows. Stand off work.

MAKE UP AND FINISH

Sew up a shoulder. Slide the standing stitches of the collar off the needle (work is automatically divided in half), pass over with a steam iron until the stitches run and sew up the elastic rib border over the neckline leaving the knit stitch inwards; work the seam in reverse st., first on the right side, then on back of work, picking up an end stitch for each stitch. Sew up the other shoulder and the sides of neck leaving a cuff. Sew up the sides. Sew up and join the sleeves.
