



# OUTFIT "DIANA"

**SIERRA ANDINA** and **BABA'** yarns

## DRESS

## YARN

**ADRIAFIL YARNS**

## MATERIALS REQUIRED

- 750 gr **Sierra Andina** yarn in violet mélange no. 96
- knitting needles no. 31/2 and no. 4

- auxiliary needles no. 4
- tapestry needle

**SIZE:** 42 (44-46)

## PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib (ending)

Knitted stitch


Purl stitch

Knit stitch to cast off the elastic rib

## CAMPIONI

10x10 cm worked with knitting needles no. 31/2 in purl stitch = 22 sts. and 30 rows.

10x10 cm worked with knitting needles no. 4 in knit stitch = 19 sts. and 27 rows.



## WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

**Back:** work in two parts. To work the "lining" of the bottom part, with knitting needles no. 4 cast on 100 (106-112) sts. and work in knit st. for 30 (32-34) cm. Stand off stitches. Working separately, with knitting needles no. 4 cast on 100 (106-112) sts. and work in knit st. for 33 (35-37) cm; place the knitting needle with the standing stitches behind the row you are working and work in knit st 1 st of the front row tog. with the corresponding st. of the back row. Cont. with knitting needles no. 31/2 in purl stitch. To shape the sides decr. at ends 1 st. every 12 rows 4 times; when work measures 22 (23-24) cm. from the closing of the bottom part increase at ends 1 st. every 8 rows 4 times. When work measures 37 (38-39) cm. from the closing of the bottom part, to shape the raglan decr. at ends, in 4 sts, 2 sts. every 4 rows 12 (13-14) times, 2 sts. every 6 rows 5 times. When work measures 24 (25-26) cm. from beg. of raglan cross off the 32 (34-36) rem. sts.

**Front:** work in same way as back until work measures 37 (38-39) cm from the closing of the bottom part. To shape the raglan cross off at ends 5 sts, then decr., in 4 sts, 2 sts. every 4 rows 7 (8-9) times, 2 sts. every 6 rows 5 times. At the same time, when work measures 15 (16-17) cm from beg. of raglan, to work the neckline cross off the 20 (22-24) centre sts. and end the two parts separately; cross off again centrewise, every 2 rows, 3 sts., 2 sts twice, 1 st 4 times.

**Right sleeve:** work in two parts. To work the "lining" of the bottom part, with knitting needles no. 4 cast on 58 (62-66) sts. and work

in knit st. until work measures 22 (23-24) cm. Stand off stitches. Working separately, with knitting needles no. 4 cast on 58 (62-66) sts. and work in knit st. until work measures 25 (26-27) cm; place the knitting needle with the standing stitches behind the row you are working and work in knit st 1 st of the front row tog. with the corresponding st. of the back row. Cont. with knitting needles no. 3 1/2 in purl stitch At ends incr. 1 st. every 6 rows twice, 1 st. every 8 rows 10 times. When work measures 30 (31-32) cm. from the closing of the bottom part work the raglans as follows: rightwise cross off 4 sts, then cont. in same way as front; on left of work in same way as back. At the same time, when work measures 20 (21-22) cm. from beg. of raglan cross off rightwise 3 sts every 2 rows 6 times, 2 sts.

**Left sleeve:** work to match right sleeve.

**Collar:** with knitting needles no. 3 1/2 cast on 115 (119-123) sts. and work in purl st for 25 cm. Cont. in elastic rib for 2 rows, then cast off the stitches in knit st with the tapestry needle.

### MAKE UP AND FINISH

Sew up the raglan. Cast off the collar with a loop then sew up the side edges. Sew up the collar around the neckline fitting together the seam of the collar and the seam of one of the back raglans. Sew up the sides and the under-sleeves. Fold back the bottom of the back, the front and the sleeves by 3 cm picking up the edge of the "lining"; tack the hem.

### LEGWARMERS

#### YARN

#### ADRIAFIL YARNS

#### MATERIALS REQUIRED

- 150 grs Sierra Andina yarn in violet mélange no. 96
- knitting needles no. 2 1/2
- tapestry needle

#### PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib (beg. and end)

K2/p2 rib stitch

Knit stitch to cast off the elastic rib

#### GAUGE

10x10 cm worked with knitting needles no. 2 1/2 in k2/p2 rib st = 50 sts. and 45 rows.


#### WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

N.B. In order to obtain a more compact effect use smaller knitting needles than those indicated by the label.

**Legwarmers:** cast on 106 sts. and work 4 rows in rib st., then cont. in k2/p2 rib st. When work measures a total of 39.5 cm. work 4 rows in rib st., then cast off the stitches in knit st with the tapestry needle.

#### MAKE UP AND FINISH

Sew up the side edges.



#### BAG

#### YARN

#### ADRIAFIL YARNS

#### MATERIALS REQUIRED

- 200 gr **Babà** yarn in colour no. 89
- knitting needles no. 9
- dark wine red cloth fabric in the following sizes: 2 37x50 cm rectangles (lining), 2 12x40 cm and strips (sleeves) and 2 3x45 cm strips (tie-ups)
- sewing needle
- tapestry needle

#### PATTERN STITCHES

Knitted stitch


#### GAUGE

10x10 cm worked with knitting needles no. 9 in knit st. = 9 sts. and 13 rows.

#### WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

Front section: cast on 30 sts. and work in knit st. When work measures a total of 38 cm. cross off all the sts.

Work back in same way as front.



#### MAKE UP AND FINISH

**Lining:** overlap the 2 fabric rectangles then sew up the side edges and the bottom edge. Make a 4 cm hem along the upper edge.

Sew the side edges of the 2 knitwear parts together. Insert the lining into the knitwear part, joining it along upper edge to the corresponding of the knitwear part leaving all the extra lining free downwards. Join the side edges of the knitwear part to the lining with several invisible stitches. Fold the handles in half lengthwise; join the end to the opening edge of the bag, and a handle at each end, 8 cm from the side. Braid the tie-up horizontally through the stitches, at 7 cm. from the opening edge, leaving the extra ends on the side and then tie them together. Wind the yarn several times to make two 10 cm skeins and sew them at the centre; join 1 skein to the base of one handle and the other skein to the base of the second handle. Widen the loops of the skein to make a flower.

## **NECKLACE**

### **YARN**

#### **ADRIAFIL YARNS**

### **MATERIALS REQUIRED**

- several grs of **Babà** yarn in colour no. 89
- 110 cm of 1 cm wine red velvet ribbon
- 120 cm of 1.5 cm wine red organza ribbon

### **WORKING INSTRUCTIONS**

**Necklace:** cut two 110 cm strands from the yarn and join them to the velvet ribbon. Knot together all the ends with a double knot, leaving a length of 10 cm free, closing the threads with a loop. Wind the yarn several times to make four 10 cm skeins fastening them at the middle with several stitches; join the skeins along the necklace spacing them evenly (or as you like). Cut four 30 cm strips from the organza ribbon, and 1 strip around each skein, including the threads of the necklace, then tie into a bow. Cut four 15 cm strands from the yarn and knot them to the fastening of the necklace. Open the loops of the skein to make a flower.
