



## **OUTFIT "MINERVA"**

**MEGA** yarn

### **CAPE**

#### **YARN**

**ADRIAFIL YARNS**

#### **MATERIALS REQUIRED**

- 300 gr Mega yarn in brown no. 33
- crochet hook no. 8

- tapestry needle

**SIZE:** 42 (44-46)

#### **PATTERN STITCHES**

Chain stitch

Treble stitch

Filet pattern (see working instructions)

#### **GAUGE**

10x10 cm worked with crochet hook no. 8 in filet pattern = 7 sts (equal to about 2 squares) and 2.5 rows.

#### **WORKING INSTRUCTIONS**

**Cape:** cast on a chain stitch of 86 (92-98) sts. and, as from the 8<sup>th</sup> ch from the crochet hook, work in filet pattern as follows:

Row 1: 1 tr, \* 2 chs, slip 2 base chs, 1 tr in the next ch \*, rep. from \* to \*.

Row 2: 5 chs, slip the 1<sup>st</sup> space, 1 tr in the next tr, \* 2 chs, slip the next space, 1 tr in the next tr \*, rep. from \* to \*

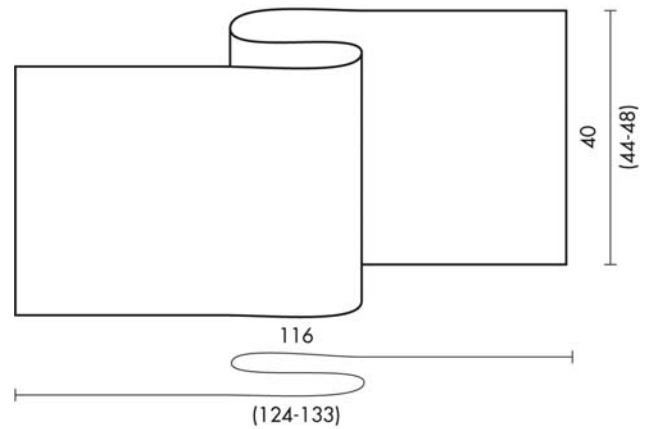
From row 3: repeat row 2

When work measures a total of 40 (44-48) cm. break off and bind the yarn.

Shoulder straps: make two 45 cm chains.

#### **MAKE UP AND FINISH**

Fold the shoulder straps in half and sew them on as follows: one shoulder strap at one end of the upper edge of the cape and the other shoulder strap at 75 (77-79) cm. from the previous but over the second last row.



### **CAP**

#### **YARN**

**ADRIAFIL YARNS**

#### **MATERIALS REQUIRED**

- 100 gr **Mega** yarn in brown no. 33
- knitting needles no. 10
- tapestry needle

#### **PATTERN STITCHES**

Knitted stitch

#### **GAUGE**

10x10 cm worked with knitting needles no. 10 in knit st. = 7 sts. and 11 rows.

#### **WORKING INSTRUCTIONS**

**Cap:** cast on 36 sts. and work in knit st. When work measures a total of 26 cm. cross off all the sts.

#### **MAKE UP AND FINISH**

Close the rectangle worked with a loop then sew up the side edges. Sew up the upper edge leaving the previous seam at the back centre.

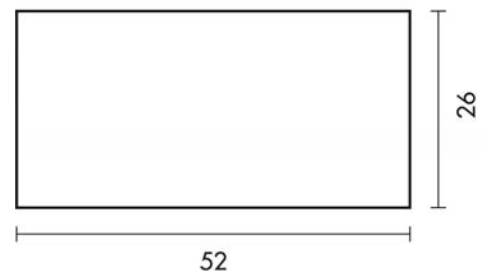
### **BAG**

#### **YARN**

**ADRIAFIL YARNS**

#### **MATERIALS REQUIRED**

- 200 gr Mega yarn in brown no. 33



- crochet hook no. 8
- tapestry needle

### PATTERN STITCHES

Chain stitch

Treble stitch

Filet pattern (see working instructions)

### GAUGE

10x10 cm worked with crochet hook n. 8 in filet pattern = 7 sts (equal to about 2 squares) and 2.5 rows.

### WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

**Bag:** cast on 29 st chain and, as from the 8<sup>th</sup> chain from the crochet hook, work in filet pattern as follows:

Row 1: 1 tr, \* 2 chs, slip 2 base chs, 1 tr in the next ch \*, rep. from \* to \*.

Row 2: 5 chs, slip the 1<sup>st</sup> space, 1 tr in the next tr, \* 2 chs, slip the next space, 1 tr in the next tr \*, rep. from \* to \*

From row 3.: repeat row 2

When work measures a total of 80 cm. break off and bind the yarn.

**Sleeves:** cast on a 5 st chain and, as from the 4<sup>th</sup> chain from the crochet hook, work

Row 1: 1 tr in each of the next 2 chs

Row 2: 3 chs, 1 tr in each of the next 2 trs

From row 3: repeat row 2

When work measures a total of 70 cm. break off and bind the yarn.

Work 2 sleeves in the same way.

### MAKE UP AND FINISH

Fold the bag (35x40 cm) in half then sew up the side edges. Join the ends of the sleeves, crossing these once at the ends of the opening.
