



# **"ENIGMA" CARDIGAN**

***DUO COMFORT*** yarn

## **YARN**

**ADRIAFIL YARNS**

## **MATERIALS REQUIRED**

- 950 gr. **Duo Comfort** yarn in colour no. 80 worked double
- knitting needles nos. 6 and 7
- cable needle no.6
- 4 matching buttons
- tapestry needle

**SIZE:** 50

## **PATTERN STITCHES**

K2/p2 rib st.

Garner stitch

Lace stitch A (work over 8 sts.):

Row 1: \* k2 tog., 1 yarn over \*, rep. from \* to \*.

Row 2: in purl stitch.

Row 3: rep. from row 1

Lace stitch B (work over 8 sts.):

Row 1: \* 1 yarn over, p2 tog. \*, rep. from \* to \*.

Row 2: in knit st.

Row 3: rep. from row 1

## **GAUGE**

10x10 cm. worked with knitting needles no. 7, with the yarn doubled in the various sts. = 13 sts. and 18 rows.

## **WORKING INSTRUCTIONS**

N.B. Work with yarn doubled.

**Back:** with knitting needles no. 6 cast on 82 (66-74) sts. and, for the border, work in k2/p2 rib st. for 12 cm.; stand off work. With knitting needles no. 6 cast on 82 sts. and work k2/p2 rib st. for 6 cm.. Overlap the 2 knitting needles leaving a small border above the large border; work in knit stitch 1 st. of the front needle tog. with the corresponding st. of the back needle. Work the return row in purl stitch. Cont. with knitting needles no. 7 and work: 1 edge st., \* 8 sts. for lace st. B, 8 sts. in garner st. \*, rep. from \* to \* and end with 1 edge st. \*\* After 16 rows, work: 1 edge st., \* 8 sts. in garner st., 8 sts. for lace st. A \*, rep. from \* to \* and end with 1 edge st. After 16 rows work: 1 edge st., \* 8 sts. for lace st. A, 8 sts. in garner st. \*, rep. from \* to \* and end with 1 edge st. \*\*. Rep. from \*\* to \*\* to end of work. When work measures 28 (24-26) cm. from the border, for the sleeves cast on at the ends, another 16 sts. and work over these stitches, alternating the pattern stitches as established previously. After 34 (30-32) cm. cross off all the sts.

**Right front:** with knitting needles no. 6 cast on 47 (41-44) sts. and, for the border, work 5 sts. in garner st. and 42 (36-39) sts. in k2/p2 rib st. starting with k2. When work measures 2 cm. work a buttonhole inside the first 2 sts.; then, work another 3 buttonholes, in the same position as the prev., spaced by 10 cm. When work measures 12 cm. stand off work. With knitting needles no. 6 cast on 42 (36-39) sts. and work k2/p2 rib st., starting with k2, for 6 cm. Overlap the 2 knitting needles leaving the small border above the large border and matching only the stitches worked in k2/p2 rib st. ; work in knit stitch 1 st. of the front needle tog. with the corresponding st. of the back needle. Work the return row in purl stitch. Cont. with knitting needles no. 7, decr. 1 st. over row 1 and work: \*\* 5 sts. in garner st., \* 8 sts. for lace st. A, 8 sts. in garner st. \*, rep. from \* to \* and end with 8 (0-4) sts. in lace st. A and 1 (3-2) edge sts. After 16 rows, work 16 rows as follows: 5 sts. in garner st., \* 8 sts. in garner st., 8 sts. for lace st. A \*, rep. from \* to \* and end with 8 (0-4) sts. in garner st. and 1 (3-2) edge sts. \*\*. Rep. from \*\* to \*\* to end of work. When work measures 18 cm. from the border, to shape the neckline decr. on right of work, inside the first 5 sts., 1 st. every 4 rows 10 times, 1 st. every 6 rows twice. At the same time, when work measures 28 from the border, to shape the sleeve, cast on, on left of work, another 16 sts. and work over these stitches, alternating the pattern stitches as established previously. After 34 (36-40) cm. cross off on left of work 45 (39-42) sts. for the shoulder and sleeve and cont. over the 5 rem. sts. for the border of the back neckline, in garner st. After 9 cm. cross off the sts.

**Left front:** work to match the right front, excluding the buttonholes and establishing the sts. after the border as follows: \*\* 1 edge st., \* 8 sts. in garner st., 8 sts. for lace st. B \*, rep. from \* to \* and end with 13 (7-10) sts. in garner st. After 16 rows work 16 rows as follows: 1 edge st., \* 8 sts. for lace st. B, 8 sts. in garner st. \*, rep. from \* to \* and end with 8 (2-5) sts. for lace st. B and 5 sts. in garner st. \*\*, Rep. from \*\* to \*\* to end of work.

## **MAKE UP AND FINISH**

Sew up the shoulders and the top section of the sleeves. Join the final borders of each front together; sew the border along the back neckline. With knitting needles no. 6 pick up 68 (60-64) sts. at the base of each sleeve and work k2/p2 rib st. for 5 cm.; cross off the sts. In the same way, pick up 68 (60-64) sts. at the base of the border worked, on wrong side of work, and work k2/p2 rib st. for 10 cm.; cross off the sts. Sew up the sides working the seam of each border only with the corresponding border. Sew up the underarms and side edges of the borders, each separately from the other. Sew the inner edge of the small border of each front at the beg. of the 5 st. buttoning side border. Sew on the buttons along the buttonhole side of the left front, next to the buttonholes.
