



"TIMIDO" PULLOVER

PASTELLO yarn

YARN
ADRIAFIL YARNS

MATERIALS REQUIRED

- 650 gr. **Pastello** yarn in grey no. 24
- knitting needles no. 10
- crochet hook no. 8
- tapestry needle

SIZE: 50 (48-52)

PATTERN STITCHES

Elastic rib (beg. and end)

K1/p1 rib st.

Knit stitch

Knit stitch to bind the elastic rib

Chain stitch

GAUGE

10x10 cm. worked with knitting needles no. 10 in knit st. = 9.5 m. and 12.5 rows.

WORKING INSTRUCTIONS

N.B. For a more compact effect, use knitting needles one size smaller than those indicated by the label.

Back: cast on 61 (57-65) sts. and, for the border work 4 rows in elastic rib, then cont. in k1/p1 rib st. When work measures a total of 8 cm. cont. in knit st. decreasing 7 sts. spaced evenly over row 1. When work measures 33 (31-35) cm. from the border, to shape the raglan cross off at the ends 3 sts., then decr., inside 3 sts., 1 st. every 2 rows 15 (13-17) times. When work measures 25 (23-27) cm. from beg. of raglan cross off the 18 rem. sts.

Front: work in same way as back until work measures 48 (44-52) cm. from the border. To shape the neckline cross off the 8 centre sts. and end the two parts separately; cross off again centrewise 1 st. every 2 rows 4 times. At the same time complete the raglan in same way as back.

Sleeves: cast on 33 (31-35) sts. and work the border in same way as back. Cont. in knit st. decreasing 5 sts. spaced evenly over row 1. At the ends incr. 1 st. every 10 rows 4 times. When work measures 37 (35-39) cm. from the border, to shape the raglan cross off at the ends 3 sts., then decr., inside 3 sts., 1 st. every 2 rows twice, 1 st. every 4 rows 5 (4-6) times. When work measures 20 (18-22) cm. from beg. of raglan decr., at the ends of the 2 centre sts., 1 st. and 1 st. after 4 rows. When work measures 25 (23-27) cm. from beg. of raglan cross off the 8 rem. sts.

MAKE UP AND FINISH

Sew up the raglan on 3 sides leaving open a back raglan. Pick up 59 (57-61) sts. around the neckline and, to shape the collar, work in k1/p1 rib st. for 6 cm.; cont. in elastic rib for 6 rows, then bind the stitches with the tapestry needle. Sew up the last raglan and the sides of the collar. Sew up the sides and the underarms. With the crochet hook (or tapestry needle) shape with 1 row in chain stitch, on right side of work, at the base of the collar and the end of the edges of the sleeves, back and front.
